While watching a party of Jungle Boddies a Shrike flew very fast out of the wood and struck me level really level both landing on the edge of a stream. The hawk then tried to fly off with the Jungle Boddies which were still alive but only managed to remain in the stream - it eventually flew off leaving the Jungle Boddies dead in the stream.

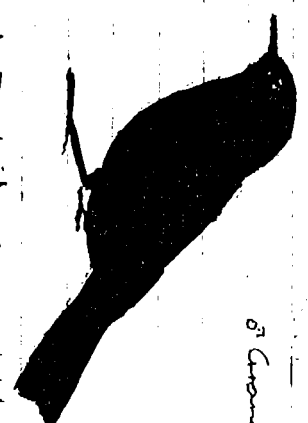
