A Checklist of the Birds and Mammals seen in NEPAL
during the twenty-three day period from the 8th to
the 30th March 1985 by David L.Clugston, Barry S.Barnacal
and Valerie A.McFarland.

The total number of bird species identified in Nepal was 346 plus Grey Hornbill and Brahminy Myna which were seen in New Delhi.

115 species were recorded in the Kathmandu valley.

231 species were recorded on the trek and around Pokhara.

176 species were recorded around Saura.

The maximum number of species recorded on any one day was 105 species seen in the Saura area on the 25th March.

ITINERARY

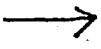
- 8th March. Arrived New Delhi (India) on British Airways flight from London early am. Arrived Kathmandu (Nepal) on Royal Nepal Airways flight mid morning. Kathmandu valley : Gokarna and the Bagmati river.
- 9th March. Kathmandu valley : Godaveri Botanical Gardens (1525m) and Phulchowki summit (2760m)
- 10th March. Kathmandu valley : Swayambhunath and Godaveri.
- 11th March. Departed Kathmandu for morning flight to Pokhara (819m) Commenced trek mid-day moving north-west along the Yamdi Khola valley at approx. 1100 meters.
- 12th March. Trek to Pothana via Dhampus (1799m).
- 13th March. Trek to Modi Khola via Landrung (1646m).
- 14th March. Trek to Ghandrung area (c2200m).
- 15th March. Trek to Ghandrung ridge (3000m).
- 16th March. Ghandrung ridge to Ghorepani (2850m).
- 17th March. Ghorepani, Poon Hill (3100m) and trek down to Tirkedhunge (1500m).
- 18th March. Trek on down to Modi Khola valley via Birethante (1037m).
- 19th March. Modi Khola valley (1100m).
- 20th March. Trek to Suiket (1113m) via Chandrakot (1600m) and Naudanda (1425m).
- 21st March. Return to Pokhara mid-morning. Phewa Tal in pm.
- 22nd March. Pokhara: Phewa Tal and Begnas Tal (c700m).
- 23rd March. Depart by bus early am for Saura, Royal Chitwan National Park (200m).
- 24th March. Saura, Royal Chitwan National Park.
- 25th March. Saura.
- 26th March. Saura.
- 27th March. Saura.
- 28th March. Depart Saura by private jeep for Kathmandu.
- 29th March, Kathmandu valley: Godaveri.
- 30th March. Kathmandu valley: Tokha Sanatorium area (DLC). Depart early evening for flight to Delhi.

Thus $4\frac{1}{2}$ days were spent birding in the Kathmandu valley, 10 days on the trek to and from Ghorepani, $1\frac{1}{2}$ days around Pokhara, 5 days at Saura on the edge of the Royal Chitwan National Park and approximately 2 days travelling within Nepal.

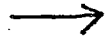
