Here, enclosed, my notes for Nepal for
Winter 84-85. - Mostly just locations & lists. but a
few numbers for areas visited more than once (eg Phulchowki,
Nagarjung) or where I stayed a while (ie. Koshi) or both
(Chitwan).

I haven't highlighted the more unusual records @ because in
1979 @ I didn't want to overshadow the other stuff and @ you would
probably be more adept at picking out the less usual stuff as you
are more aware of species status.

I have however included notes on very rare species - as in some
you would want to know the details.

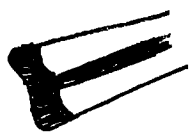
SCAP - Pennant Tail 8th Feb

♀ type; associative with a ♀ Topped Duck on the shore
edge at eastern end of lake - from Topped Duck, larger,
broader girth, paler brown body & head, pale cheek patches
Bill blue looking, broader (when head on) more up-tipped
cutting edge. less extensive black tip (no. 1 only). Remnant
white face band, back of head rounded, showing no suggestion
of a crest. Breast same color as flanks (on Topped breast
intermediate between color of head and pale flanks)

RED WHEATEAR Tskhe 11th Jan

Winter ♂. Much like a Eastern Pied Wheatear seen a couple
of weeks previously, but appeared smaller & sliver, more
like a wheatear or Black eared wheatear in shape. Bill
brownish black above, blacker on throat, paling slightly as
it ^{is} ^{superseded}. Black not extending onto breast as on
EPW, this one instead washed with all orange flight
feathers & rather fringed brown. white rump & much white
in tail.

Note - There was some initial confusion as to
identity as we only had the illustration in the
Pictorial Guide to the subcontinent to go by, and this
showed a Red with a white crown. This is however largely lost in winter,
and the other 2 similarly plumaged wheatears from this guide, PTO.

Hornes 5 Eastern Red could be eliminated by size. extent of black below. all orange breast and (?) mottled upperparts.

GRASSHOPPER WARBLER

! Probable 11/4 1 or 2 definite 13/4

Basically Olive-brown above, Yellowish buff below. ^{Melphale!} ^{Throat} Breast unmarked. Under-tail coverts marked with  Upperparts streaked from crown to rump. Tertials and wing coverts ending dark brown. Giving contrasting appearance to upperparts. (Although not as contrasting as lancey) long thin supercilium from bill to end of ear coverts. Tail (although damp) showed growth bars on central feathers and no paling at tip (cf. P.G.Tips). Pinky legs, pale flesh lower mandible. Rump not obviously brighter than mantle (again cf. P.G.Tips).

If you would like any further descriptions, or numbers for stuff let me know, alternatively, if you find any of the records dodgy I would also be interested!
