Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge area, 4 on 6 March.

BANDED BAY CUCKOO

Tiger Tops Tented Camp, one seen, 5 March.

BROWN HAWK OWL

Kathmandu, heard calling regularly on east side of city at Dwarika's Hotel grounds, 1-2 & 7 March.

WHITE-RUMPED SPINETAIL

At least one over forest near Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge, 4 March.

BROWN-CAPPED PYGMY WOODPECKER

Party of 4 seen near Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge, 3 March.

RED-RUMPED SWALLOW

Kathmandu, present in valley at this early date, ie. Godaveri, 2 on 1 & 7 March and 5 en route to Tokha on 3 March.

WHITE-TAILED BLUE ROBIN

Fine male at Godaveri botanical gardens, 7 March.

LARGE BUSH WARBLER

One at Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge, 4,5 & 6 March.

ABERRANT BUSH WARBLER

Several about Tiger Tops, both Jungle Lodge & Tented Camp, 1-7 March.

GREY-SIDED BUSH WARBLER

Two near Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge, 5 March.

LANCEOLATED WARBLER

One reported by Tented Camp at Tiger Tops by Richard Koeppel, 4 March - good description, brief view of small warbler, heavily streaked above and below, flitted over path and skulked into bottom of dense grass by damp hollow. Sure its OK, we were stood near him at time trying to get to grips with something else in a tree. He has seen the species before.

LARGE GRASS WARBLER

I would like to retract our 1974 record of this species at Kosi, I feel that they must have been Striated Marsh Warblers. On the other hand they could have been there I suppose, the area we had them in in 1974 was in tall elephant grass to west of "pink tower" and this habitat has now changed a great deal from what I can remember. Sorry that this means an alteration to your book, but feel it safer especially as nobody else seems to have had it there.

One in Godaveri botanical gardens, 1 March.

TICKELL'S WARBLER At least 2 by Kosi barrage, 27 Feb.

PALE BLUE FLYCATCHER

Female in Godaveri botanical gardens, 7 March.
RUSTY-CHEEKED SCIMITAR-BABBLER

Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge, 2 at a rather low altitude, 6 March.

SLENDER-BILLED BABBLER

Tiger Tops, ca.8 in "florican area" to east of the Lodge, 5 March.

BANK MYNAH

Kathmandu, 2 on outskirts of city on Godaveri road, 6-7 March.

STREAKED WEAVER
Kosi barrage, ca.20 on 27 Feb.
