## **NEPAL TRIP DECEMBER 2001**

## **ITINERARY**

- 4<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Arrived Tribhuvan Airport Kathmandu at 11-45am. Taxi to Tibet Guest House. At 1-30pm we took a taxi to Nagarjung. Birded from the bottom gate up the small path almost to the top. Returned the same way at dusk arriving at the hotel at 6pm.
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6am. Taxi (old Toyota Corrolla) to Phulchowki Mountain at 6-45am. Puncture, petrol then traffic congestion meant we arrived at the base of Phulchowki at 8-15. Eventually reached the summit, (after much frustration, see daily diary) birding on the way up and on the way down. Returned in the dark around 6pm.
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 5am. Hired 4x4 from our hotel (2300N Ru). Arrived Phulchowki base at 6am and the pond area, between halfway house and the summit, at 6-45am. Birded summit area and below in the morning but had to return to the summit to avoid the thick mist. Birded halfway house area and below around mid-day, and then spent 1 hour in the Ravine at 1-30pm. Finished off at Godaveri, in the vicinity of the Botanical Gardens. Left at 4-45pm arriving at the hotel at 5-45pm. During the evening we heard unconfirmed reports that there was to be a transport strike, called by the Maoists, for the following morning. Consequently we cancelled our 5am breakfast.
  - 7<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6-30am. It was an absolute fiasco. We should have birded Phulchowki lower slopes but because of the strike, the hotel 4x4 could not be used. Instead, we took a Cycle Rickshaw to Nagarjung around 8am. Birded the road from the bottom gate to the top gate. Went into the forest reserve through the top gate at mid-day, but very quiet. Reached the bottom gate, again by the road, at 2-30pm and met our Rickshaw drivers for the return trip to the hotel.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Hotel taxi at 7am to Nagarjung. Birded the road again similar to the previous day. Returned at 11-15am for our 11-30am pickup to Kathmandu domestic airport. Flight to Biratnagar took 45 mins. Met by Hathan, our birdguide for the next four days. Arrived at Koshi camp at 4pm after a 70 minute drive from the airport. Birded compound until dusk.
  - 9<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast 6-30am. All day boat ride, 9am until 3pm, with Henk, Manon and Som, their guide. Numerous stops were made to bird sandbanks, islands, etc and included lunch. Eventually we had a 6km walk along the river embankment, which was lined with trees, bushes, shrubs and pools. We reached the jeep at 5-20pm (dark) for the hour long journey back to camp.
  - 10<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast 6-30am. Short jeep ride to the embankment, west of the camp. Walked the 4km back to the camp, along the embankment, birding all the way. Arrived at 12-20pm just in time for lunch. At 2pm we walked East, along the embankment for 3km, with various detours onto the edge of the grasslands, looking for raptors and owls in the forest. Met the jeep at 4-30pm for the trip back to the camp. Spent the last 30 minutes of daylight looking for crakes and rails.
  - 11<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6-30am. At 7-15am we had a 75 minute jeep ride to the Dharan forest (with H, M and Som). Birded the forest and dried up riverbeds all day. Arrived back at camp at 6pm.

- 12<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast 7pm. Left for Chitwan NP at 8am in tandem with H, M and Som. Packed lunch at Parsa Wildlife Reserve. Reached Hetauda at 2pm. Checked 3 sections of the river before finding Ibisbill. Arrived at Gaida Wildlife Jungle Lodge at 4-15pm. After tea and biscuits, we spent the last 30mins of daylight with Bishnu, our birdguide for the next four days, in the Lodge compound.
- 13<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Birding compound at 7am until breakfast at 8-30am. Jeep ride to 20,000 Lake, birding on the way. Returned to the Lodge at 1pm for lunch. Birding in the compound again until 3pm when we went birding in the grasslands on Elephant back. Returned two hours later. In the compound, around 9pm, we tried "pulling" Owls in, but without success.
- 14<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Birding compound at first light until Breakfast at 8-15am. Took the Jeep to the canoe ferry at Sauraha at 8-45am, for our trip to Gaida Tented Camp in the middle of the forest. Arrived at 11-30am after birding the rough track through the grassland for two hours. Met Henk and co at the camp. Birded camp environs for the rest of the day before returning for the last canoe ferry at 5pm.
- 15<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Our last full day together for the team of four. After an early breakfast we left again for the Gaida Tented Camp. Met Henk and co at the ferry crossing at 7-50am. Arrived at the camp at 10am after a short walk through the grassland and forest to the Watch Tower Hide. Birded camp environs until lunch around 1pm. At 2-15pm walked slowly back to the river, via the forest and grassland. Birded river for 30 minutes (Falcated Duck etc) before catching the ferry at 5pm. We said our goodbyes (for the third time!) to Henk, Manon and Som before boarding the Jeep for the lodge. Tried for Collared Owlet in the compound but without success.
- Met Bishnu at 7am for our last walk around the compound before breakfast at 8am. At 9-15am we said our goodbyes to Martin and Allen and left by Jeep for our tourist bus back to Kathmandu. We arrived at 3-50pm but this included a 45minute stop for lunch at Kurintor. Returned to the Tibet Guest House.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6am. Took a pre-arranged taxi at 6-30am for Phulchowki, arriving at the Ravine at 7-30am. Spent nearly two hours in the ravine before driving further up the mountain, to just below halfway house. From there, we walked all the way down, arriving at the quarry gates at 1-30pm. Bought two boiled eggs from the stall opposite the gate (lunch) before birding the areas around the Quarry, the Red brick buildings and the Botanical Gardens. Left at 4pm for our hotel.
- 18<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6am. Berni took the hotel taxi to Nagarjung top gate at 6-30am. (I went back to bed) In the forest reserve, he took the small path near the gate, not the broad track, birding for an hour, before returning to the main road. Walked down to the bottom gate and beyond for a taxi back to the hotel around noon. Left the hotel at 5-45pm for the 9-20pm Transavia flight back to Manchester, via Sharjah and Amsterdam.
- 19<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Arrived Manchester at 9am, two hours late.

## ITINERARY EXTENSION

- 16<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Martin and Allen left the Lodge at 10am, by Jeep, to Chital Lodge, Meghauli (Jibs place) arriving at 11-30am. Birded Lodge environs all afternoon.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast 7am. Departed at 7-30am for the walk to Chitwan. Three rivers had to be crossed, two of them by wading knee deep in the water, before reaching the Bhimle entrance to Chitwan (fee 500Ru each). Arrived at Tiger Tops Jungle Lodge at 10-30am. Birded lodge environs until 3pm, before the walk back to Jibs place, birding all the way. Arrived at 5pm.

- 18<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Up at 5am. Caught the local bus to Pokhara at 5-45am, arriving there at noon. Taxi to Hotel
  Tulsi (recommended by Hem). Lunch at the Moonlight Restaurant by the Lake at 1-30pm.
  Birding at the Fish Tail Lodge for the last two hours of daylight. They were delighted to bump into Henk, Manon and Som at the hotel. It's a small world!
- 19<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast 7am. At 7-45am, took a taxi to the footbridge at the Southern end of the Lake. Walked the track leading to the Temple for approximately 2 hours before returning to Fish Tail Lodge for lunch at 1-45pm. At 2-30pm birded the "dump" area at the Lodge until 4-45pm. Taxi back to Hotel Tulsi. Arranged porter/guide (\$6 per day) for the start of the trek on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 20<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 7am. At 7-30am took a taxi part way (2/3rds) to the North end of the Lake. Birded marshy/paddyfield area adjacent to lake. At 10-30am caught the local bus to the North end of the lake. Birded lake environs until 2pm. Again caught the local bus back to the hotel. At 2-30pm, took a taxi to Fish Tail Lodge and covered the "dump" area and gardens until 5pm. Returned to hotel by taxi.
- 21<sup>st</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 7am. At 7-45am, met our porter Bhuban and took a taxi to Naya Pul arriving at 9am. From there, walked for 30minutes to Birethanti (altitude 1000M) and registered for the Trek at the checkpost. Continued the walk, birding along the way, to Indra Lodge at Tikhedhunga (1525M). Had lunch there at 2pm, before continuing up the "stone steps" to Annapurna View Point Lodge, Ulleri (2080M) at 4-30pm.
- 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec '01 At 7-30am we continued up the remaining "stone steps" to the Himchuli Restaurant for breakfast at 8-30am. Continued the trek at 9-15am, reaching the Hungry Eye Restaurant at Nangathanti (2460M) at noon. After some Tea and a short rest, pressed on to Ghorapani, (2750M) arriving at 2-20pm. Had lunch at Latiguras Lodge. At 3pm, continued on to Deorali (2870M) and booked in at the Snow View Lodge. Birded the last hour around Deorali.
- 23<sup>rd</sup> Dec'01 Breakfast 7am. Left at 7-30am on the Ghandruk path up onto the ridge (3210M) before dropping down to the Deorali Tea Rooms (3090M) for lunch. At 1pm, started back for the Snow View Lodge, arriving at 4pm. Spent the last hour birding the gardens there.
- 24<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 At 5-20am Martin and Bhuban set off for the Viewpoint Watch Tower at Poon Hill, arriving at 6-05am. At 7am returned to the lodge for breakfast. At 8am, took the path to Poon Hill but then went along the right hand fork, which skirts the NW slopes of Poon Hill, for about 3km. Returned to Ghorapani for lunch at 2-15pm. After lunch, checked the gardens at Ghorapani, before exploring the trekking path towards Chitre. Returned to the Snow View Lodge at 4-45pm.
- 25<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Departed at 7-15am on our return journey to Pokhara. Breakfast at 9-30am at the Green View Lodge, Banthanti (2250M). Pressed on to Tikhadhunga arriving at the Indra Lodge at 1-15pm. After a two hour break, birded the Lodge environs until dusk.
- 26<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 7am. Birded Lodge environs before leaving at 8-15am for Birethante. Arrived at 1-30pm and had lunch at the New River View Lodge. Departed for Naya Pul at 2-15pm. From there, took a taxi to Pokhara, arriving at the Hotel Tulsi at 4pm.
- 27<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 7am. Took a taxi to the footbridge at the South end of the Lake. Birded the lower path through the forest Warden's House and along the hillside for about 1.5km, before returning on foot to the Fish Tail lodge at 11-30am. Birded "dump" area for an hour and then took a break for lunch. After lunch continued to bird the "dump" area and the gardens. Returned to the Hotel Tulsi at 4pm.

- 28<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 7am at the Lakeside Bar and Restaurant. Took a taxi to the footbridge at the South end of the Lake. Took the same path as the previous day but continued all the way to the temple at the top of the hill. Raptor watching for approximately two hours before returning on foot to the Hotel Tulsi at 4-30pm. Arranged taxi at the hotel for Kathmandu the following morning.
- 29<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Departed at 7am for Kathmandu via Mugling. Stopped for lunch at the Hilltop Restaurant, Golghar. Arrived in Kathmandu at 1pm and went straight to the Tibet Guest House at Thamel. Chilled out for the rest of the day.
- 30<sup>th</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 5-30am. At 6am took hotel taxi to Phulchowki, arriving at the base in thick fog at 7-30am. Pressed on to halfway house (Allen having to drive at times) before walking/driving back down to the Botanical Gardens for lunch at 1pm. At 2pm birded the area around the gardens, red brick buildings and quarry until 4pm. Returned to the hotel.
- 31<sup>st</sup> Dec '01 Breakfast at 6am. At 6-30am took the hotel 4x4 to the summit of Phulchowki arriving at 8-30am. Birded there all day before returning to the hotel at 3-45pm.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02 Breakfast at 6-30am. Took taxi to Nagarjung Top Gate (300NR). Birded main track for about 3km, but very quite, so returned to the main road around 9-45am. Walked down to the lower gate and beyond before getting a taxi (100NR) to the hotel at noon. Left the hotel at 5-45pm for the 9-20pm Transavia flight back to Manchester, via Sharjah and Amsterdam.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Jan '02 Arrived Manchester at 7am.

- 1. BLACK FRANCOLIN *Francolinus francolinus* 2 seen in the grasslands at Chitwan from the Elephant ride on the 13<sup>th</sup>, with 3 seen the following day from the Jeep on the drive from Sauraha to Gaida Tented Camp.
- 2. SWAMP FRANCOLIN *Francolinus gularis* Seen or heard daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>, with max 16 on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. HILL PARTRIDGE Arborophila torqueola 1 heard at Ulleri on the morning of the 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- 4. RUFOUS-THROATED PARTRIDGE *Arborophila rufogularis* 3 seen and 1 heard in the Ravine at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>, another seen and heard between the Ravine and halfway house on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 5. RED JUNGLEFOWL *Gallus gallus* 1 at Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; regularly seen and heard at Chitwan, 13th to 17<sup>th</sup> inclusive, with max 12 on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. KALIJ PHEASANT Lophura leucomelanos 1 in the forest at Pokara on the 27<sup>th</sup>, 3 there the following day; 5 at Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; 8 at Nagarjung on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Jan '02.
- 7. INDIAN PEAFOWL *Pavo cristatus* A single at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, with max 10 on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

- 8. LESSER WHISTLING-DUCK *Dendrocygna javanica* 30+ seen on the embankment pools, after the boat ride, at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 20+ seen at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan, on the 13th
- 9. RUDDY SHELDUCK *Tadorna ferruginea* Common in all suitable habitats at Koshi and Chitwan, with max 60 on the 9<sup>th</sup>, on the pool at Koshi.
- 10. COTTON PYGMY-GOOSE *Nettapus coromandelianus* 10+ on the embankment pool, at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 11. GADWALL *Anas strepera* 10+ on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and a single on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 20 on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 25+ at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 12. FALCATED DUCK *Anas falcata* A first winter male on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>. Reported to be its 14<sup>th</sup> day.
- 13. EURASIAN WIGEON *Anas penelope* 40+ on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 40+ on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 20 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 14. MALLARD *Anas platyrhynchos* Seen on 5 days at Koshi and Chitwan, with max 70 on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 50+ at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 15. SPOT-BILLED DUCK *Anas poecilorhyncha* 3 flying over the embankment near the Koshi camp on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 16. NORTHERN SHOVELER *Anas clypeata* 6 on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Phewa Tal, Pokara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 17. NORTHERN PINTAIL *Anas acuta* 15+ on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 20 on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 3 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 18. GARGANEY *Anas querquedula* A single on the embankment pool after the boat ride, at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 19. COMMON TEAL *Anas crecca* Seen on 4 days at Koshi with max 50 on the embankment pool on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 10 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 20. RED-CRESTED POCHARD *Rhodonessa rufina* Seen on 5 days with max 8 on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 21. COMMON POCHARD *Aythya ferina* 10+ on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, a single there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single on the river by the ferry crossing at Sauraha, Chitwan, on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 6 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 22. FERRUGINOUS POCHARD *Aythya nyroca* 15 on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 2 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 10 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 23. TUFTED DUCK *Aythya fuligula* 1 on the embankment pool at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 2 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan, on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 30 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 24. COMMON MERGANSER *Mergus merganser* 4 at Koshi, on the 9<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan on the river with max 6 on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 25. EURASIAN WRYNECK *Jynx torquilla* 3 from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the grasslands at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 3 more near Jibs place, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

- 26. SPECKLED PICULET *Picumnus innominatus* Singles at Phulchowki base on the 6<sup>th</sup> and the 13<sup>th</sup>; Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup> and near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 27. GREY-CAPPED PYGMY WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos canicapillus* 5 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> inclusive, with max 4 on 3 dates; a single in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>
- 28. BROWN-FRONTED WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos auriceps* Singles seen on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> near Phulchowki summit.
- 29. FULVOUS-BREASTED WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos macei* A male at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> inclusive, max 3; singles in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Nagarjung on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02.
- 30. RUFOUS-BELLIED WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos hyperythrus* Singles on Phulchowki near halfway house on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>; a female on the Ghandruk path between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- 31. DARJEELING WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos darjellensis* A single seen near Phulchowki summit on the 6<sup>th</sup>; a male on the lower NW slopes of Poon Hill, on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 32. RUFOUS WOODPECKER Celeus brachyurus A single in the Dharan forest on the 11th.
- 33. LESSER YELLOWNAPE *Picus chlorolophus* 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup> inc max 2; 2 in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 34. GREATER YELLOWNAPE *Picus flavinucha* Singles at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 4 in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 2 there on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 35. STREAK-THROATED WOODPECKER *Picus xanthopygaeus* Singles at Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 36. GREY-HEADED WOODPECKER *Picus canus* 3 in the forest around Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 37. HIMALAYAN FLAMEBACK *Dinopium shorii* Singles near Jib's place at Meghauli, and near the Bhimle entrance, Chitwan, both on the 17<sup>th</sup>
- 38. BLACK-RUMPED FLAMEBACK *Dinopium benghalense* 3 seen from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup> and another there on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 39. GREATER FLAMEBACK *Chrysocolaptes lucidus* 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 2 seen at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, with one heard there on the 16<sup>th</sup>.
- 40. GREAT BARBET *Megalaima virens* 2 seen by the road at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup> and another there on the 18<sup>th</sup>; heard from the garden at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 18<sup>th</sup>, 2 seen there on the 27<sup>th</sup>; a single on the forest slopes near the Temple at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 28<sup>th</sup>; heard at Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- <sup>41.</sup> LINEATED BARBET *Megalaima lineata* 4 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; present at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup> with max 4 on 14<sup>th</sup>.

- 42. BLUE-THROATED BARBET *Megalaima asiatica* 5 by the road at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup> and another there on the 18<sup>th</sup>; daily at Koshi 9<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup>, max 8 on the 9<sup>th</sup>; a single at Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 1 in the garden at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 18<sup>th</sup>, with 2 there on the 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 43. COPPERSMITH BARBET *Megalaima haemacephala* 2 at Koshi on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 3 there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; heard near Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 44. ORIENTAL PIED HORNBILL *Anthracoceros albirostris* 5 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 2 near Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 1 near Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 45. COMMON HOOPOE *Upupa epops* 1 Phulchowki base on the 6<sup>th</sup>; seen at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>, max 7 on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Chitwan on the 12<sup>th</sup>, and 8 whilst walking back from Gaida Tented camp to the river on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 46. RED-HEADED TROGON *Harpactes erythrocephalus* Heard in the forest near Gaida tented camp on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15th.
- 47. INDIAN ROLLER *Coracias benghalensis* Seen on 7 days at Koshi and Chitwan, max 3 on the 8<sup>th</sup>. 1 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup> was considered to be of the eastern race *affinis*.
- 48. DOLLARBIRD Eurystomus orientalis A single in the Dharan forest on the 11th was a nice surprise!
- 49. COMMON KINGFISHER *Alcedo atthis* Between 1 and 3 seen at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and at Chitwan 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 50. BLUE-EARED KINGFISHER *Alcedo meninting* A hat-trick of sightings at the Gaida tented camp on the 15<sup>th</sup>, all different birds
- 51. STORK-BILLED KINGFISHER *Halcyon capensis* 1 in the camp compound at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 3 at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> inclusive.
- 52. WHITE-THROATED KINGFISHER *Halcyon smyrnensis* Daily at Koshi 7<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>, max 6; daily at Chitwan 12<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup>, max 20+ on the 12<sup>th</sup> during the drive from Koshi to Chitwan; 1 at Nagarjung on the 18<sup>th</sup>; up to 3 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; 6 seen on the drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 53. CRESTED KINGFISHER Megaceryle lugubris 1 on the Bhurungdi Khola close to Hille, on the trek on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 54. PIED KINGFISHER *Ceryle rudis* 12 seen on the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, with 5 at Koshi the following day; singles at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup> and near Jib's place, Meghauli on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 55. BLUE-BEARDED BEE-EATER Nyctyornis athertoni A single near the Gaida Tented camp on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 56. GREEN BEE-EATER *Merops orientalis* Seen at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, with 40+ there, along the embankment, on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 6 at Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 57. LARGE HAWK CUCKOO *Hierococcyx sparverioides* 1 seen well by all in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Nagarjung on the 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 58. COMMON HAWK CUCKOO *Hierococcyx varius* 1 seen after the boat trip on the embankment at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
  - CUCKOO Sp A bird seen well in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>, was attributed to the Hepatic morph of Indian Cuckoo, by our bird guide, but per Grimmett/Inskipp, "There is said to be no Hepatic morph"?

- 60. GREATER COUCAL *Centropus sinensis* Seen on 3 days at Koshi, max 12 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 3 daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 61. LESSER COUCAL *Centropus bengalensis* Between 1 and 2 daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the Chitwan grasslands on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 62. ALEXANDRINE PARAKEET *Psittacula eupatria* 3 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup>, max 10 on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 63. ROSE-RINGED PARAKEET *Psittacula krameri* Up to 3 around our hotel in Kathmandu on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>; present at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, max 75; daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> /17<sup>th</sup>, max 100 on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 64. SLATED-HEADED PARAKEET *Psittacula hymalayana* 20 in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 65. PLUM-HEADED PARAKEET *Psittacula cyanocephala* 50 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> in smaller numbers.
- 66. HIMALAYAN SWIFTLET *Collocalia brevirostris* At Nagarjung 3 on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 4 on the 8<sup>th</sup>; 6 near the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; good numbers at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup>, with max 400 on the 19<sup>th</sup>.
- 67. WHITE-RUMPED NEEDLETAIL *Zoonavena sylvatica* 2 at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 6 over the 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, a single at Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 68. ASIAN PALM SWIFT *Cypsiurus balasiensis* Only 2 singles positively identified near Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Probably overlooked.
- 69. ALPINE SWIFT Tachymarptis melba 6 seen over the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 70. HOUSE SWIFT *Apus affinis* 40+ at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; 30+ with Himalayan Swiftlets at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>; 20 at Phulchowki base on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 71. CRESTED TREESWIFT *Hemiprocne coronata* 3 seen at Parsa Wildlife Reserve during the journey to Chitwan, on the 12<sup>th</sup>, with 6 more near the Gaida Tented camp on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 72. BARN OWL Tyto alba 1 seen over the temples in the Durbar Square, Kathmandu, on the 6<sup>th</sup>. (BL only)
- 73. BROWN FISH OWL *Ketupa zeylonensis* 1 seen in the woods adjacent to the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; another heard near the Gaida Tented camp, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 74. BROWN WOOD OWL Strix leptogrammica 1 seen well during the Elephant ride at Chitwan, on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 75. TAWNY OWL Strix aluco 1 heard at Poon Hill at 6-30am on the 24th. (MN only)
- 76. ASIAN BARRED OWLET *Glaucidium cuculoides* 2 singles in the forest at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 19<sup>th</sup>
- 77. JUNGLE OWLET *Glaucidium radiatum* 3 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; up to 2 daily at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup>/16th.
- 78. SPOTTED OWLET *Athene brama* Seen or heard at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, max 4 seen on the 10<sup>th</sup>; heard at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup>/13<sup>th</sup>.

- 79. BROWN HAWK OWL *Ninox scutulata* A pair seen at a daytime roost at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single, seen at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>.

  NIGHTJAR Sp A single was seen, rather poorly, at dusk on the embankment, 1 hours drive West of the Koshi Camp on the 9<sup>th</sup>.

- 83. SPOTTED DOVE *Streptopelia chinensis* Common at Koshi and Chitwan, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, daily max 80; 1 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 84. RED COLLARED DOVE Streptopelia tranquebarica 2 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 85. EURASIAN COLLARED DOVE *Streptopelia decaocto* Daily at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>, max 50; seen at Chitwan, 15<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup>.
- 86. EMERALD DOVE Chalcophaps indica Daily at Chitwan 12th to the 17th, max 6 on the 14th.
- 87. WEDGE-TAILED GREEN PIGEON *Treron sphenura* A female seen from the stone steps leading up to Ulleri on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 88. PIN-TAILED GREEN PIGEON Treron apicauda 3 near Gaida Tented Camp on the 15th.
- 89. POMPADOUR GREEN PIGEON Treron pompadora A single near Gaida Tented Camp on the 14th.
- 90. YELLOW-FOOTED GREEN PIGEON *Treron phoenicoptera* At Chitwan, 1 near Gaida Tented Camp on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 3 near the Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 91. BROWN CRAKE *Amaurornis akool* Beween 1 and 2 daily by the river at Gaida Jungle Lodge, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup>; a single by the river at Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 92. WHITE-BREASTED WATERHEN *Amaurornis phoenicurus* Between 1 and 4 at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup> and on the 12<sup>th</sup>; a single at Jib's Place on the 17<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 3 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> and on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 93. RUDDY-BREASTED CRAKE Porzana fusca At Koshi Camp, 2 on the 10<sup>th</sup> and a single on the 12<sup>th</sup>.
- 94. PURPLE SWAMPHEN *Porphyrio porphyrio* 5 at a roadside stop near Koshi Barrage on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 3 at the NW end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20th.
- 95. COMMON MOORHEN *Gallinula chloropus* Daily at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>, max 75; single figure counts at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 96. COMMON COOT *Fulica atra* In Koshi Camp compound, 1 on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 2 on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 8 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 30 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20th.
- 97. PINTAIL SNIPE *Gallinago stenura* 1 by the Dungre river at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 12<sup>th</sup>, 3 there on the 15<sup>th</sup>. (BL only)

  SNIPE Sp An unidentified snipe was flushed 3 times in marshy fields at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

- 101. GREEN SANDPIPER *Tringa ochropus* 4 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 2 most days at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup>.
- 102. COMMON SANDPIPER *Actitis hypoleucos* 8 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, a single on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 4 on the 12<sup>th</sup>; singles at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>; 2 by the river near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 103. TEMMINCK'S STINT *Calidris temminckii* 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 near Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup>; singles at Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 104. GREATER PAINTED-SNIPE Rostratula benghalensis An adult with 3 well grown chicks at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 105. PHEASANT-TAILED JACANA *Hydrophasianus chirurgus* 6 on pools adjacent to the river following the boat ride at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 106. BRONZE-WINGED JACANA *Metopidius indicus* Seen daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>, with 15+ on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 5 at a road side stop near Koshi Barrage on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 10 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 20+ at the NW end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

- 111. RED-WATTLED LAPWING *Vanellus indicus* Seen at Koshi, 2 during the boat trip on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 3 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 8 seen on the river at Sauraha, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 112. PALLAS'S GULL *Larus ichthyaetus* An adult winter bird was seen during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 113. BLACK-HEADED GULL *Larus ridibundus* A first winter bird on the river near Sauraha, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 114. RIVER TERN Sterna aurantia 6 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 4 there on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 115. BLACK-BELLIED TERN Sterna acuticauda 2 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>.

- 116. OSPREY *Pandion haliaetus* 3 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 2 there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 near 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 1 on the way to Meghauli on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

- 118. BLACK-SHOULDERED KITE *Elanus caeruleus* Singles at Koshi on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 119. BLACK KITE *Milvus migrans* Common in the Kathmandu Valley, with 100 there on the 7<sup>th</sup> seen daily around Pokhara, max 20 on the 28<sup>th</sup>; not seen at Koshi and only one seen at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 120. WHITE-TAILED EAGLE Haliaeetus albicilla 1 at Koshi during the boat trip on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 121. GREY-HEADED FISH EAGLE *Ichthyophaga ichthyaetus* 1 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 2 near Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 122. EGYPTIAN VULTURE Neophron percnopterus An adult at Pokhara on the 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup>, and again 27<sup>th</sup> to the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 123. WHITE-RUMPED VULTURE *Gyps bengalensis* 6 from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single above the forest at Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 2 there on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 124. EURASIAN GRIFFON *Gyps fulvus* 2 from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 10 and 30 above the forest at Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>; 2 near Ghorapani on the 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- 125. CINEREOUS VULTURE Aegypius monachus Singles at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>; 2 over the forest at Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 126. RED-HEADED VULTURE *Sarcogyps calvus* A single over the forest at Pokhara on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>, 2 there on the 28<sup>th</sup>; 1 near Birethante at the start of the trek on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 127. SHORT-TOED SNAKE EAGLE Circaetus gallicus 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, another there on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 128. CRESTED SERPENT EAGLE *Spilornis cheela* Singles at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 3 at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Fish Tail Lodge gardens, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 129. EURASIAN MARSH HARRIER Circus aeruginosus 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, another there on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 130. HEN HARRIER *Circus cyaneus* 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, another there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single at Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 131. PALLID HARRIER *Circus macrourus* Good views of a male on the drive from Koshi to the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 132. PIED HARRIER *Circus melanoleucos* Between 2 and 4 daily at Koshi Camp, 8<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>. Generally seen early morning/evening as the birds flew to/from a roost.
- 133. SHIKRA *Accipiter badius* Between 1 and 3 most days in the Kathmandu Valley, Koshi and Chitwan from the 4<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>. Only 2 seen after the 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 134. WHITE-EYED BUZZARD Butastur teesa 2 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.

- 135. COMMON BUZZARD *Buteo buteo* Between 1 and 2 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>; at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; on route to Chitwan on the 12<sup>th</sup>. A single at Ghorapani, 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>, showed characteristics of the sub-species *japonicus*
- 136. BLACK EAGLE *Ictinaetus malayensis* A single over the lower slopes at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>; a single at the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 137. LESSER SPOTTED EAGLE *Aquila pomarina* 1 from the embankment at Koshi on the 10th, 1 near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 138. GREATER SPOTTED EAGLE *Aquila clanga* 4 adults during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 1 from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a single between Karintor and Kathmandu on the 16<sup>th</sup>, during a 10 min stop of the Tourist Bus.
- 139. STEPPE EAGLE *Aquila nipalensis* 1 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 9 on the 8<sup>th</sup>, and 4 more on the 18<sup>th</sup>; singles from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>; on the trek on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, 3 more over the forest at Pokhara on the 28<sup>th</sup>; 4 near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>. - 142. BOOTED EAGLE *Hieraaetus pennatus* Singles at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 at the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20th.
- 143. MOUNTAIN HAWK EAGLE Spizaetus nipalensis 1 on the trek near Ulleri on the 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- 144. COLLARED FALCONET *Microhierax caerulescens* 3 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; singles at Chitwan, near 20,000 Lake on the 13<sup>th</sup> and at Gaida Tented Camp on the 14<sup>th</sup>.

- 148. LITTLE GREBE *Tachybaptus ruficollis* 4 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> seen at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on four days, max 25+ on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 149. GREAT CRESTED GREBE *Podiceps cristatus* A single at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20th.
- 150. DARTER Anhinga melanogaster 6 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 2 there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 3 at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 151. LITTLE CORMORANT *Phalacrocorax niger* Daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, max 40 during the boat trip on the 9<sup>th</sup>.

- 152. GREAT CORMORANT *Phalacrocorax carbo* Between 10 and 20 at Koshi 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> almost daily at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, with a max of 200 on the river near Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

LITTLE EGRET *Egretta garzetta* Daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, max 20 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, with a max of 60 on the 15th single figure counts at Phewa Tal, Pokara on the 20<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>.

- 155. PURPLE HERON Ardea purpurea Between 1 and 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 156. GREAT EGRET *Casmerodius albus* Daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, max 15 during the boat trip on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 157. INTERMEDIATE EGRET *Mesophoyx intermedia* Between 20 and 30 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>; present at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 10 at Phewa Tal, Pokara on the 20<sup>th</sup>,
- 158. CATTLE EGRET *Bubulcus ibis* Common and widespread except on the trek. High counts included 200+ near Koshi Barrage on the 12<sup>th</sup> and a roost at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, held around 300 birds on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>.

- 165. ASIAN OPENBILL *Anastomus oscitans* Between 1 and 10 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>; 20+ at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, with singles there on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 166. WOOLLY-NECKED STORK Ciconia episcopus Singles at Chitwan on the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 167. BLACK STORK *Ciconia nigra* Between 1 and 3 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 near Sauraha, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 3 on the river between Meghauli and Bhimle entrance on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 168. BLACK-NECKED STORK Ephippiorhynchus asiaticus 1 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 169. LESSER ADJUTANT *Leptoptilos javanicus* Singles at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, 12 in marshy fields at a roadside stop near Koshi Barrage, on the 12<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 3 daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>.

- 185. BLACK-HOODED ORIOLE *Oriolus xanthornus* Between 2 and 6 daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12 to 17<sup>th</sup>, with max 12 on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 186. - 198. WHITE-BELLIED DRONGO *Dicrurus caerulescens* 2 at koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup> singles at Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 199. BRONZED DRONGO *Dicrurus aeneus* 2, at Nagarjung on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02 and in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; singles at Chitwan, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> with 8 there, near Tiger Tops, on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the forest at Pokhara on the 28<sup>th</sup>.

- 207. BLUE ROCK THRUSH *Monticola solitarius* Single males in the Koshi Camp compound on the 10<sup>th</sup> and at Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 208. BLUE WHISTLING THRUSH *Myophonus caeruleus* Between 1 and 3 at Nagarjung, 4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>; at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; in the forest around Phewa Tal, Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup>, 27th and 28<sup>th</sup>; between 3 and 8 daily on the trek, Naya Pul to Ulleri on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.

- 216. DARK-THROATED THRUSH *Turdus ruficollis* 12 below Phulchowki summit on the 6<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 30+ on the Ghandruk path near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 12 at Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 217. WHITE-BROWED SHORTWING *Brachyteryx montana* Close range views of a female at the "dump", Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> and on the 27<sup>th</sup>.

SIBERIAN RUBYTHROAT *Luscinia calliope* Singles seen and between 2 and 6 heard daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>; either this or the next species heard near Gaida Jungle Lodge, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> and a male seen near Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 228. WHITE-TAILED RUBYTHROAT *Luscinia pectoralis* Singles seen near Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>; this or previous species heard on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 229. BLUETHROAT Luscinia svecica Singles at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 230. ORANGE-FLANKED BUSH ROBIN Tarsiger cyanurus Between 1 and 2 at Phulchowki, 5<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; a male on the trek at Ulleri on the 22nd and 2 females at Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 231. GOLDEN BUSH ROBIN *Tarsiger chrysaeus* A female above halfway house on Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>; single females on the trek at Nangathanti on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and near Ghorapani on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- ORIENTAL MAGPIE ROBIN *Copsychus saularis* Between 1 and 2 at Nagarjung, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; almost daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, max 8 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 4 at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> and at Pokhara, 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> to the 29<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.

- 233. WHITE-RUMPED SHAMA *Copsychus malabaricus* Between 1 and 3 daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup>, 5 seen on the walk from Jib's Place, Meghauli, to Tiger Tops on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 234. BLUE-CAPPED REDSTART *Phoenicurus coeruleocephalus* A pair on the Ghandruk path near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 12 on the slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 235. BLACK REDSTART *Phoenicurus ochruros* 2 from the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a male at the base of Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 236. HODGSON'S REDSTART *Phoenicurus hodgsoni* A male by the road adjacent to Godaveri Gardens, Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 237. WHITE-THROATED REDSTART *Phoenicurus schisticeps* A pair on the Ghandruk path near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- 238. BLUE-FRONTED REDSTART *Phoenicurus frontalis* A female below Phulchowki summit on the 6<sup>th</sup>, a pair there on the 31<sup>st</sup>; between 3 and 6 daily on the trek, 22<sup>nd</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> and a male there on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- WHITE-CAPPED WATER REDSTART *Chaimarrornis leucocephalus* 2 at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 3 at Kurintor, between Mugling and Kathmandu on the 16<sup>th</sup>; singles at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, (by Fish Tail Lodge) on the 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>. On the trek between Birethante and Tikhadhunga, 8 on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 6 on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 240. PLUMBEOUS WATER REDSTART *Rhyacornis fuliginosus* 6 at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 6 near Kurintor, between Mugling and Kathmandu on the 16<sup>th</sup>; a female at Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 17<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 4 daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, (by Fish Tail Lodge) on the 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. On the trek between Birethante and Tikhadhunga, 15 on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 10 on the 26<sup>th</sup>; a pair at Phulchowki base on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 241. WHITE-TAILED ROBIN Myiomela luecura A male seen at close range at the "dump", Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara, on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 242. LITTLE FORKTAIL *Enicurus scouleri* Singles in Tiger Tops compound on the 17<sup>th</sup> and on the trek at Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 243. SLATY-BACKED FORKTAIL *Enicurus schistaceus* Singles at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, by Fish Tail Lodge on the 18<sup>th</sup> and near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 244. BLACK-BACKED FORKTAIL *Enicurus immaculatus* 1 on the river by Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 16<sup>th</sup> with 2 there the following day.
- 245. SPOTTED FORKTAIL *Enicurus maculatus* At Phulchowki, singles in the ravine on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> and, on the stream below the "red brick buildings", a pair there on the 17<sup>th</sup> and a single on the 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, 2 at Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 1 there on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 1 near Ghorapani on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 246. COMMON STONECHAT *Saxicola torquata* Almost daily at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>, max 20 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 4 daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup>; around Phewa Tal, Pokhara, 12 at the northern end on the 20<sup>th</sup>, 1 at the southern end on the 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 1 at Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup>, with 2 there on the 26<sup>th</sup>.

- WHITE-TAILED STONECHAT *Saxicola leucura* 2 during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; a male on the way to the Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 8 on the return walk from Gaida Tented Camp to Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 5 on the walk from Jib's Place to Bhimle entrance on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 248. PIED BUSHCHAT Saxicola caprata Between 1 and 6 daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>; a female at Pokhara on the 28<sup>th</sup> and 3 at roadside stops near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 249. GREY BUSHCHAT *Saxicola ferrea* A pair near the "red brick buildings" at Godaveri on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>, a male there on the 17<sup>th</sup>, 5 on the trek between Ghorapani and Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>; a pair at Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 250. CHESTNUT-TAILED STARLING *Sturnus malabaricus* Between 6 and 15 daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup>; 9 in the compound at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan, on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 251. BRAHMINY STARLING Sturnus pagodarum 6 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 252. ASIAN PIED STARLING *Sturnus contra* Daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>, max 100 on the 10<sup>th</sup> and at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup>.
- 253. COMMON MYNA *Acridotheres tristis* Common throughout except on the trek, max 100+ at Koshi on the 8<sup>th</sup>.
- 254. BANK MYNA *Acridotheres ginginianus* 50+ seen in the cattle fields on the return walk from Gaida Tented Camp to the ferry crossing at Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 255. JUNGLE MYNA Acridotheres fuscus Up to 10 Kathmandu/Nagarjung, 5<sup>th</sup> to the 7<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; 2 at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 2 at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Common in the centre of Pokhara, with up to 50 around the Hotel Tulsi, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 256. HILL MYNA *Gracula religiosa* 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 257. CHESTNUT-BELLIED NUTHATCH *Sitta castanea* 1 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; singles at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> and 6 in the forest near Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 258. WHITE-TAILED NUTHATCH *Sitta himalayensis* Between 2 and 8 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>, a single at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; 2 on the slopes of Poon Hill, on the trek, on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 259. VELVET-FRONTED NUTHATCH *Sitta frontalis* 30+ at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup> in a huge mixed feeding flock, 15 there on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 1 on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Jan '02, 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, around Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>, 6 in the forest at Bhimle entrance, Chitwan, on the 17<sup>th</sup>; up to 6 daily in the forest at Pokhara, 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the trek at Birethante on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 260. WALLCREEPER Tichodroma muraria 1 by the river at Birethante on the 21st. (AH only)
- 261. RUSTY-FLANKED TREECREEPER *Certhia nipalensis* On the trek, singles on the Ghandruk path near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 262. BROWN-THROATED TREECREEPER Certhia discolor 1 on the lower slopes of Phulchowki and 1 near the quarry at the base of Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.

- 263. RUFOUS-VENTED TIT *Parus rubidiventris* Between 5 and 20 daily on the trek, 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>, Ulleri to Deorali and around Ghorapani, Poon Hill and the Ghandruk path.
- 264. GREY-CRESTED TIT *Parus dichrous* Between 2 and 12 daily on the trek, 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>, around Ghorapani, Poon Hill and the Ghandruk path.
- 265. WINTER WREN *Troglodytes troglodytes* 1 seen well below Phulchowki summit on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 1 at Deorali, next to Ghorapani, on the trek on the 24<sup>th</sup>. Both were noticeably darker than Wrens seen in England.
- 266. GREAT TIT *Parus major* Between 3 and 4 at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>,30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, max 4; in the forest at Pokhara, 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, max 5; 1 at Nagarjung on the 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 267. GREEN-BACKED TIT *Parus monticolus* 6 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 6<sup>th</sup>; between 4 and 6 daily on the trek, from Birethante to Ghorapani, on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 268. BLACK-LORED TIT *Parus xanthogenys* Between 6 and 8 at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; at Nagarjung, 40 on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 20+ on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 6 on the 18<sup>th</sup>; between 6 and 15 in the forest at Pokhara, (especially Fish Tail Lodge) on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; up to 10 on the trek, Birethante to Ulleri, 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 269. YELLOW-BROWED TIT *Sylviparus modestus* 6 on Phulchowki, mid slopes on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 1 there on the 6<sup>th</sup>; 1 near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 3 on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 270. BLACK-THROATED TIT *Aegithalos concinnus* Up to 15 daily at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> respectively; 1 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; 3 between Ulleri and Ghorapani on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, 8 there on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 271. PLAIN MARTIN *Riparia paludicola* 2 at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 4 there on the 10<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, max 100+ on the 14<sup>th</sup>; present at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 272. BARN SWALLOW *Hirundo rustica* Up to 10 daily at Nagarjung, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; at Koshi 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, max 100 on the 17<sup>th</sup>; daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, max 200 on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 273. RED-RUMPED SWALLOW *Hirundo daurica* 20+ at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 5 on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 18<sup>th</sup>; between 10 and 30 daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>; present at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup> and Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 5 over the river at Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 274. NEPAL HOUSE MARTIN *Delichon nipalensis* 2 at Hetauda on the 12<sup>th</sup>; 2 over Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara, on the 27th and 28<sup>th</sup>; 2 near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 275. BLACK-CRESTED BULBUL *Pycnonotus melanicterus* 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 2 near the Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 276. RED-WHISKERED BULBUL *Pycnonotus jocosus* Daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>, max 6 on the 11<sup>th</sup> and at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, max 30+ on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 277. HIMALAYAN BULBUL *Pycnonotus leucogenys* Between 5 and 8 at Nagarjung, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup>
  Jan '02; 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup> and Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 4

- at Pokhara, 19<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, from Birethante to Ulleri, on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>, 6 there on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 12 on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 278. RED-VENTED BULBUL *Pycnonotus cafer* Between 8 and 12 at Phulchowki, 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; at Nagarjung on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12th, max 100+ on the 10<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>, max 30+ on the 17<sup>th</sup>; up to 10 at Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> to the 29<sup>th</sup> and on the trek, 10 near Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 279. MOUNTAIN BULBUL *Hypsipetes mcclellandii* At Nagarjung, 2 on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 50+ in a huge feeding flock on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 30 on the 8<sup>th</sup>; 10 at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 8 there on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 20 on the 30<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 1 at Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 2 near Hille on the 26th.
- 280. BLACK BULBUL *Hypsipetes leucocephalus* At Phulchowki, 2 on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 60 below the summit on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 80+ on the lower slopes on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>, 40+ there on the 30<sup>th</sup>; 35 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 20 there on the 8<sup>th</sup>.
- 281. ZITTING CISTICOLA *Cisticola juncidis* 6 in the grassland adjacent to the river near the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 2 in the grassland near Sauraha, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 5 there on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 3 in the marshy fields/paddies towards the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 282. GREY-CROWNED PRINIA *Prinia cinereocapilla* 2 in the grassland on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 283. GREY-BREASTED PRINIA *Prinia hodgsonii* Seen on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, 4 on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 8 on the 15<sup>th</sup>: 6 in open woodland near Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 284. GRACEFUL PRINIA *Prinia gracilis* 1 in grassland adjacent to the embankment, 4km west of the Koshi Camp on the 10<sup>th</sup>
- 285. YELLOW-BELLIED PRINIA *Prinia flaviventris* 2 from the Elephant ride at Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup>; seen on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, 1 on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 286. ASHY PRINIA *Prinia socialis* A single in scrubby grassland after the ferry crossing at Sauraha, on the way to the Gaida Tented Camp on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 287. PLAIN PRINIA *Prinia inornata* At Koshi, 1 near the camp on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 2 near the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>; seen on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, 1 on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 15<sup>th</sup>, 1 at Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- ORIENTAL WHITE-EYE Zosterops palpebrosus Up to 10 at Phulchowki base on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; 12 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>; present at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 6 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; up to 10 seen or heard daily at Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>. Single figure counts at Pokhara,19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; max 10 on the trek, Birethante to Ulleri on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 289. CHESTNUT-HEADED TESIA *Tesia castaneocoronata* 1 seen well at Nagarjung on the 18<sup>th</sup>; 2 seen rather poorly on Phulchowki lower slopes on the 30<sup>th</sup>, both were calling and sang briefly.

- 290. GREY-BELLIED TESIA *Tesia cyaniventer* Seen well at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara and in the forest behind, 1 on the 18<sup>th</sup>, 6 on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 3 on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 1 heard on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 291. PALE-FOOTED BUSH WARBLER *Cettia pallidipes* Heard in the forest around Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan, 3 on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 seen close to the Bhimle entrance on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 292. ABERRANT BUSH WARBLER *Cettia flavolivacea* At Phulchowki base, 1 seen on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 1 heard on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 3 seen on the 31<sup>st</sup>; seen and heard at Nagarjung, 1 on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 4 on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 10 on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02 (mainly heard); 1 on the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 close to the Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 1 seen and heard in an open area, high up in the forest at Pokhara, near the temple on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the trek near Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 293. GREY-SIDED BUSH WARBLER *Cettia brunnifrons* At Nagarjung, 2 heard on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 2 heard and seen there on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 1 seen on the 18<sup>th</sup> and another heard on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02 (all next to the road on the open side, not the forest side); 2 heard close to Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 294. SPOTTED BUSH WARBLER *Bradypterus thoracicus thoracicus*, 2 in a marshy area close to the Elephant compound at Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Both were heard calling and 1 sang briefly several times, over a period of 90 minutes. No views were obtained.
- 295. PADDYFIELD WARBLER *Acrocephalus agricola* 1 in the Koshi Camp compound on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 10th.
- 296. BLYTH'S REED WARBLER Acrocephalus dumetorum Singles at Jib's Place, Meghauli on the 16<sup>th</sup> and at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 20th.
- 297. CLAMOROUS REED WARBLER *Acraocephlus stentoreus* At Koshi, singles in the camp compound and at a stop during the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 1 from the embankment on the 10th.
- 298. THICK-BILLED WARBLER *Acrocephalus aedon* At Koshi, a single in the camp compound on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 1 at a stop during the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 1 from the embankment on the 10th.
- 299. COMMON TAILORBIRD *Orthotomus sutorius* 1 at Nagarjung on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 2 there on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 3 on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; up to 6 daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> and Chitwan, 13<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 3 daily at Pokhara, 26<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Phulchowki base on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - **Note:** Many Phylloscopus/Seicercus warblers were not identified as they moved through the canopy in substantial numbers. The systematic list reflects only the birds seen well enough to identify.
- 300. COMMON CHIFFCHAFF *Phylloscopus collybita tristis* At Koshi, 1 during the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 12 from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 1 on the 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 301. DUSKY WARBLER *Phylloscopus fuscatus* 1 at Koshi from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>; 1 seen at close range and heard at the "dump", Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 302. SMOKY WARBLER *Phylloscopus fuligiventer* 1 seen very well at 20,000 Lake, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 1 seen well and heard calling in marshy fields/paddies towards the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 303. TICKELL'S LEAF WARBLER *Phylloscopus affinis* At Koshi, 1 on the 6km walk following the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 3 from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>.

- 304. BUFF-BARRED WARBLER *Phylloscopus pulcher* Seen at Phulchowki, 20+ on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 25 on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 6+ on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 10 on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, singles near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup> and Ghorapani on the 24th.
- 305. ASHY-THROATED WARBLER *Phylloscopus maculipennis* 1 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>; between 1 and 5 daily on the trek from Ulleri to Ghorapani on the 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 306. LEMON-RUMPED WARBLER *Phylloscopus chloronotus* 15+ at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, with 3 there on the 8<sup>th</sup>; in the forest at Pokhara, 5 on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 6 on the 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek between Birethante and Ulleri, 4 on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 2 on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 10 on the 26<sup>th</sup>; 2 at Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 307. YELLOW-BROWED WARBLER *Phylloscopus inornatus* 2 at Nagarjung on the 4<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Koshi Camp compound on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 1 at Gaida Tented Lodge, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>; in the forest at Pokhara, 2 on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 2 at Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>; 4 at Phulchowki on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 308. HUME'S WARBLER *Phyloscopus humei* At Koshi, 4 on the 6km walk following the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 1 in the compound on the 11<sup>th</sup>; 1 at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>; in the forest at Pokhara, 5 on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 2 on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 6 on the 27<sup>th</sup>, up to 4 daily on the trek, 22<sup>nd</sup> to the 26<sup>th</sup>; 1 near Mugling on the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 309. GREENISH WARBLER *Phylloscopus trochiloides* 3 at Nagarjung on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 1 on 8<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>; between 10 and 15 daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>; daily at Chitwan, 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, max 25 on the 13<sup>th</sup>; up to 8 daily at Pokhara, 18<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 310. BLYTH'S LEAF WARBLER *Phylloscopus reguloides* 2 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup> and 2 at Nagarjung on the 18<sup>th</sup>.

  GOLDEN-SPECTACLED WARBLER *Seicercus burkii* 1 bird seen well near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup> may have been this species, it showed no wing bar and had distinct black crown sides, extending to the base of the upper mandible and was prominent when viewed from the rear, side and especially when the bird was "face on " to us, however we did not hear it call. 1 bird seen at Koshi on the 11<sup>th</sup> and another at Chitwan on the 16<sup>th</sup>, were attributed to this species by our guides, but seen only poorly by us and therefore not recorded.
- 311. WHISTLERS WARBLER *Seicercus whistleri* 2 at Tiger Tops, Chitwan, on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 6+ at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup> and another there on the 31<sup>st</sup>; 5 at Nagarjung on the 17<sup>th</sup>, with 6 there on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; up to 20 at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara and in the forest behind the lodge, on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek between Birethante and Tikhadhunga, 5 on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 20 on the 26<sup>th</sup>.

  Note: Apart from 1, (see above) all birds seen well, were considered to be this species, showing distinct wing bar and dark crown sides, falling short of the base of the upper mandible. Indeed, the dark crown stripes were clearly visible from the side or rear view, but were very difficult to see, when the bird was "face on".
- 312. GREY-HOODED WARBLER Seicercus xanthoschistos At Nagarjung,up to 30 on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; between 8 and 20 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; at Pokhara, 2 on

- the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>, 6 on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, from Birethante to Ulleri, 5 on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 2 on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, 6 on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 8 on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 313. GREY-CHEEKED WARBLER Seicercus poliogenys 1 in the ravine at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup> (BL only)
- 314. CHESTNUT-CROWNED WARBLER Seicercus castaniceps 3+ on the lower slopes of Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup> and another there on the 30<sup>th</sup>; 4 in the forest at Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup>, 1 there on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 315. BLACK-FACED WARBLER *Abroscopus schisticeps* 2 on the lower slopes of Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 8 in a single flock, in the forest close to Nangathanti on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 316. STRIATED GRASSBIRD *Megalurus palustris* 2 in grassland adjacent to the embankment, 4km west of Koshi Camp on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 317. RUFOUS-RUMPED GRASSBIRD *Graminicola bengalensis* 2 seen rather poorly in grassland, from the Elephant ride at Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup>, excellent views of 1 in grassland on the way to Gaida Tented Camp on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 1 heard there the following day.
- 318. WHITE-THROATED LAUGHINGTHRUSH Garrulax albogularis 10+ at Phulchowki below half way house on 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 319. WHITE-CRESTED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax leucolophus* At Nagarjung, 6 on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 1 on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 6 there on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '02; on the trek, 2 near Hille on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 320. LESSER NECKLACED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax monileger* At Chitwan, 6 in the forest near the Gaida Tented Camp on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 2 in the forest near Tiger Tops on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 321. STRIATED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax striatus* A single on Phulchowki, mid slopes on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31st.
- 322. RUFOUS-CHINNED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax rufogularis* 6 on the lower slopes of Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>, including 1 in the ravine and 1 seen well in the "garden" area below the red brick buildings, 1 again showing well in this latter area on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 323. SPOTTED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax ocellatus* 2 in the forest, by the Ghandruk path, between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 23rd.
- 324. STREAKED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax lineatus* 3 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 5 there on the 6<sup>th</sup>; on the trek between Banthanti and Tikhadhunga, 7 on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 325. VARIEGATED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax variegatus* 1 in the forest, by the Ghandruk path, between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 23rd.
- 326. CHESTNUT-CROWNED LAUGHINGTHRUSH *Garrulax erythrocephalus* On Phulchowki, mid slopes, 2 on the 6<sup>th</sup>, 1 on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 5 on the 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, 3 near Ulleri on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1 by the Ghandruk path, between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 23rd and 3 between Ulleri and Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 327. PUFF-THROATED BABBLER *Pellorneum ruficeps* 2 seen in the forest on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 14<sup>th</sup> and heard there on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 seen and 3 heard in the forest close to Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 19<sup>th</sup>.

- 328. RUSTY-CHEEKED SCIMITAR BABBLER *Pomatorhinus erythrogenys* 2 near the road at Nagarjung on the 8<sup>th</sup>; at Phulchowki, 2 seen below half way house and 2 at the base adjacent to the quarry on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 329. STREAK-BREASTED SCIMITAR BABBLER *Pomatorhinus rufcollis* 1 near Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>, 6 on Phulchowki on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 330. WHITE-BROWED SCIMITAR BABBLER *Pomatorhinus schisticeps* 1 near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 331. SLENDER-BILLED SCIMITAR BABBLER *Xiphirhynchus superciliaris* 2 seen and heard at the first wet gully below Tikhadhunga on the 26<sup>th</sup>. (MN only)

  WREN BABBLER Sp 1 seen briefly in the second wet gully below Tikhadhunga on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 332. BLACK-CHINNED BABBLER *Stachyris pyrrhops* 2 in the forest at Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 1 near Birethante on the 21<sup>st</sup>, 5 between Banthanti and Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>, 15 between Tikhadhunga and Birethante on the 26<sup>th</sup>; at Phulchowki, 2 on the 17<sup>th</sup>, 10 on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 5 on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 333. GREY-THROATED BABBLER Stachyris nigriceps 3 in the forest at Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 3 between Tikhadhunga and Birethante on the 26<sup>th</sup>; at Phulchowki, 6 on the 30<sup>th</sup> and 4 on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 334. STRIPED TIT BABBLER *Macronous gularis* 6 in the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 4 at Gaida Jungle Lodge and in the forest near Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, 10 in the forest at Tiger Tops, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 335. CHESTNUT-CAPPED BABBLER *Timalia pileata* 2 from the Elephant ride at Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup>; 6 heard (very skulking) in grassland on the way to Gaida Tented Camp on the 15<sup>th</sup> and finally saw 3 there on the 16<sup>th</sup>.
- 336. YELLOW-EYED BABBLER *Chrysomma sinense* 2 in grassland on the way to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>
- 337. STRIATED BABBLER *Turdoides earlei* 6 at Koshi during the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 9 from the Elephant ride at Gaida Jungle Lodge, Chitwan on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
- 338. JUNGLE BABBLER *Turdoides striatus* 14 at Koshi during the boat ride on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 21 from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>; between 7 and 14 daily at Chitwan, 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> inclusive.
- 339. RED-BILLED LEIOTHRIX *Leiothrix lutea* 3 at Phulchowki, lower slopes, on the  $17^{th}$ , 6 there on the  $30^{th}$ .
- 340. BLACK-EARED SHRIKE BABBLER *Pteruthius melanotis* Singles, at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup>; on the trek at Nangathanti on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and near Birethante on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 341. HOARY-THROATED BARWING *Actinodura nipalensis* 3 on the upper slopes of Phulchowki on the  $6^{th}$ .

- 342. BLUE-WINGED MINLA Minla cyanouroptera 1 near the ravine at Phulchowki on the 30th.
- 343. CHESTNUT-TAILED MINLA *Minla strigula* At Phulchowki, 10 on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6 on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 3 on the 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, 2 at Nangathanti on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 6 at Banthanti on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 344. RUFOUS-WINGED FULVETTA *Alcippe castaneceps* 1 at Phulchowki, lower slopes, on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 10+ there on the 30<sup>th</sup>.

WHITE-BROWED FULVETTA *Alcippe vinipectus* At Phulchowki, 20+ on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 2 on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 8 on the 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, 3 at Nangathanti on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, 4 on the Ghandruk path, between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 23rd and 25 at Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.

- 354. ASHY-CROWNED SPARROW LARK *Eremopterix grisea* 3 at a stop off during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 355. SAND LARK *Calandrella raytal* 10 at a stop off during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 8 during the walk from Jib's Place to the river crossing near the Bhimle entrance, Chitwan on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 356. ORIENTAL SKYLARK Alauda gulgula 4 at a stop off during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 357. FIRE-BREASTED FLOWERPECKER *Dicaeum ignipectus* 4 at Phulchowki, lower slopes, on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 1 on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 2 there on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 358. PURPLE SUNBIRD Nectarinia asiatica 6 along the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 359. GREEN-TAILED SUNBIRD *Aethopyga nipalensis* Between 2 and 4 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; on the trek, a pair near Ulleri on the 25<sup>th</sup> and another pair below Hille on the 26<sup>th</sup>.

- 360. BLACK-THROATED SUNBIRD *Aethopyga saturata* A male at Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>; on the trek, 3 males between Birethante and Tikhadhunga on the 21<sup>st</sup> and a male below Hille on the 26<sup>th</sup>.

- 371. RICHARD'S PIPIT *Anthus richardi* 8 at a stop off during the boat trip at Koshi on the 9<sup>th</sup>; 3 during the walk from the Gaida Tented Camp to the ferry crossing at Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 1 at the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 372. PADDYFIELD PIPIT *Anthus rufulus* 2 in fields near Koshi Camp on the 8<sup>th</sup>; at Chitwan, 2 on the way to 20,000 Lake on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 8 during the walk from the Gaida Tented Camp to the ferry crossing at Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 5 during the walk from Jib's Place to the river crossing at Bhimle on the 17<sup>th</sup>; 6 at the NW end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 373. OLIVE-BACKED PIPIT *Anthus hodgsoni* Daily at Koshi, 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>, max 40+ along the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup>; up to 25 daily at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>; between 2 and 4 around Pokhara, on

- the 19<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; 1 on the trek, Ulleri to Birethante, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>; 4 at Phulchowki on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 1 on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 374. ROSY PIPIT *Anthus roseatus* 15 in fields at a petrol stop, near Koshi Barrage on the 12<sup>th</sup>; at Chitwan, 1on the way to 20,000 Lake on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 4 during the walk from the Gaida Tented Camp to the ferry crossing at Sauraha on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 375. BUFF-BELLIED PIPIT Anthus rubescens 15 in wet fields at the NW end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 376. ALTAI ACCENTOR *Prunella himalayana* Flocks of 40 on the Ghandruk path, between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms and 30 at Ghorapani both on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 10 near Ghorapani on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 377. RUFOUS-BREASTED ACCENTOR *Prunella strophiata* 1 on the trek near Banthanti on the 25<sup>th</sup>; 3 on Phulchowki mid slopes on the 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 378. MAROON-BACKED ACCENTOR *Prunella immaculata* 5 together on the track at Phulchowki, below half way house on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 379. BAYA WEAVER *Ploceus philippinus* 2 in grassland adjacent to the embankment, 4km west of Koshi Camp on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 380. RED AVADAVAT Amandava amandava 1 on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 381. WHITE-RUMPED MUNIA *Lonchura striata* 1 near the footbridge at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 27<sup>th</sup>, 5 there on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
- 382. SCALY-BREASTED MUNIA *Lonchura punctulata* Daily at Koshi, 8<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup>, max 12 on the 10<sup>th</sup> and at Chitwan 13<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>, max 15 on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 20 at Phulchowki base on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 383. YELLOW-BREASTED GREENFINCH *Carduelis spinoides* A flock of 25 near the Botanical Gardens at Godaveri on the 17<sup>th</sup>, 29 there on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 384. PLAIN MOUNTAIN FINCH Leucosticte nemoricola A flock of 50 on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 385. DARK-BREASTED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus nipalensis* Between 5 and 12 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, and 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 386. COMMON ROSEFINCH Carpodacus erythrinus 4 at Phulchowki on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 1 there on the 17<sup>th</sup>; at Koshi, 1 on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 2 on the 10<sup>th</sup>; a male on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp, Chitwan on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 387. BEAUTIFUL ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus pulcherrimus* A female in gardens at Deorali on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, a male and female on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup> and another male in gardens at Ghorapani on the same day.
- 388. PINK-BROWED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus rodochrous* A male in gardens at Ghorapani on the 24<sup>th</sup>, 2 pairs at Tikhadhunga on the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 389. DARK-RUMPED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus edwardsii* Close views of a female, above half way house, on Phulchowki on the 6<sup>th</sup>.

- 390. SPOT-WINGED ROSEFINCH Carpodacus rodopeplus 2 females in gardens at Deorali on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2 males and a female on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>
- 391. CRIMSON-BROWED FINCH *Propyrrhula subhimachala* 2 males and a female on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>
- 392. RED-HEADED BULLFINCH *Pyrrhula erythrocephala* A pair on the Ghandruk path near Ghorapani on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 6 on the NW slopes of Poon Hill on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 393. CRESTED BUNTING *Melophus lathami* At Koshi, 3 at the start of the boat trip on the 9<sup>th</sup>, 1 from the embankment on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 2 on the way to the Dharan forest on the 11<sup>th</sup>; singles at Chitwan, on the approach to the Gaida Tented Camp on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> and near the Bhimle entrance on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 394. YELLOW-BREASTED BUNTING *Emberiza aureola* A flock of 50 in grassland adjacent to the embankment at Koshi on the 10<sup>th</sup>; at Chitwan, 20 from the Elephant ride at Gaida Jungle Lodge on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 3 on the approach to Gaida Tented Camp on the 15<sup>th</sup>; 10 in grassland towards the N end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
