- 1. HILL PARTRIDGE Arborophila torqueola 2 seen towards dusk at Chhomrong on the 15th and 17th. They were feeding in the forest close to the path between Himalayan View Guest House and Excellent View Lodge at the top of Chhomrong. Singles were heard at Chhomrong on the 18th, Tadapani on the 19th and at Ghorapani on the 21st and 22nd. 1 was heard at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- RUFOUS-THROATED PARTRIDGE Arborophila rufogularis 1 heard at Chhomrong on the 16th.
- HIMALAYAN MONEL Lophophorus impejanus 2 males on the grassy/rocky slopes above the deserted village of Kuldi (near Bamboo) on the 17th; 1 was heard calling at nearby Sinuwa on the same date.
- KOKLASS PHEASANT Purcrasia macrolopha 3 birds calling 2 of which were seen on the ridge between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd. A singlewas heard on the lower slopes of Poon Hill on the 23rd.
- KALIJ PHEASANT Lophura leucomelanos 2 in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and a female at Chhomrong on the 17th. At Phulchowki 3 birds, including 2 males, were seen on the 28th.
- BAR-HEADED GOOSE Anser indicus 2 at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th; 10 there on the 24th. On the trek, a flock of 11 circling high over Kuldi on the 17th, before moving away NW.
- RUDDY SHELDUCK Tadorna ferruginea At Phewa Tal, Pokhara 10 at the north end on the 13th and 2 on the 24th and 26th.
 - 8. GADWALL Anas strepera 20 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 13th.
 - EURASIAN WIGEON Anas penelope Up to 30 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 12th and 13th.
 - 10. MALLARD Anas platyrhynchos 4 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
 - 11. NORTHERN PINTAIL Anas acuta Up to 15 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 25th.
 - 12. COMMON TEAL Anas crecca 7 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
 - 13. COMMON POCHARD Aythya ferina Up to 25 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th and 13th.
 - 14. FERRUGINOUS POCHARD Aythya nyroca 15 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
 - 15. TUFTED DUCK Aythya fuligula Up to 50 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 25th.
 - SPECKLED PICULET Picumnus innominatus A singleclose to the quarry at the base of Phulchowki on the 28th.

- 17. GREY-CAPPED PYGMY WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos canicapillus* A singlein the forest at Pokhara on the 12th; 2 there on the 26th: 5 between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th.
- 18. FULVOUS-BREASTED WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos macei* Singles in the forest at Pokhara on the 12th and 25th.
- 19. RUFOUS-BELLIED WOODPECKER *Dendrocopus hyperythrus* A female on the ridge between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd; a pair at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 20. DARJEELING WOODPECKER *Dendrocopos darjellensis* Singles at Tadapani on the 19th and Ghorapani on the 20th; 3 between Ghorapani and Ulleri on the 23rd.
- 21. LESSER YELLOWNAPE *Picus chlorolophus* 3 in forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th, A singlethere on the 26th and 2 near Shauli Bazaar on the 14th.
- 22. GREATER YELLOWNAPE Picus flavinucha 2 near Shauli Bazaar on the 14th.
- 23. GREY-HEADED WOODPECKER Picus canus 3 in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 13th and 26th; on the trek 2 between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th and Singles on the 15th, 24th and 25th.
- 24. GREATER FLAMEBACK Chrysocolaptes lucidus 1 near Birethante on the 24th.
- 25. GREAT BARBET *Megalaima virens* Heard/seen daily except around Ghorapani 20th –22nd inclusive. Daily maximum 10 but many more heard.
- 26. GOLDEN-THROATED BARBET *Megalaima franklinii* 1 seen between Sinuwa and Chhomrong on the 17th; 1 heard near Chhomrong on the 18th. Several heard at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 27. BLUE-THROATED BARBET *Megalaima asiatica* Heard/seen daily Pokhara 12th, 13th and 25th to the 27th inclusive, daily max 6.
- 28. COPPERSMITH BARBET *Megalaima haemecephala* Heard/seen daily Pokhara 12th, 13th and 25th to the 27th inclusive, daily max 4.
- 29. COMMON KINGFISHER Alcedo atthis Seen at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 25th and 26th, daily max 2. A singlenear Birethante was the only trek record.
- 30. WHITE-THROATED KINGFISHER *Halcyon smyrnensis* Seen daily around Phewa Tal, Pokhara 11th to the 13th inclusive and 25th to the 27th inclusive, daily max 8. 2 between Birethante and Shauli Bazaar on the 14th were the only birds seen on the trek.
- 31. CRESTED KINGFISHER Megaceryle lugubris Seen around Birethante 13th, 14th and 24th, daily max 3. A single atPhewa Tal, Pokhara close to Fish Tail Lodge on the 25th.
- 32. HAWK CUCKOO Sp Birds heard calling around Pokhara/Shauli Bazaar on the 12th, 13th, 14th and 28th were either Common or Large Hawk Cuckoo.
- 33. EURASIAN CUCKOO Cuculus canorus 1 heard at Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 34. ORIENTAL CUCKOO Cuculus saturatus 2 heard at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 35. ASIAN KOEL Eudynamys scolopacea Heard at Pokhara 24th to the 26th inclusive, daily max 2.

- 36. GREEN-BILLED MALKOHA Phaenicophaeus tristis 2 in the forest below the Stupa at Pokhara on the 26th and 3 in a ravine 1/4mile before View Point Lodge on the northern edge of Pokhara on the same date.
- 37. ROSE-RINGED PARAKEET *Psittacula krameri* A singlein the forest close to the dam at Phewa on the 26th was a surprise.
- 38. SLATY-HEADED PARAKEET *Psittacula himalayana* A flock of 30 in the forest at Pokhara on the 12th. Up to 50 seen daily on the trek, 14th, 15th, 18th, 23rd and 24th. A singlewas at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 39. HIMALAYAN SWIFTLET *Collocalia brevirostris* Up to 75 seen daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara 11th to the 13th and 25th to 27th inc.
- 40. HOUSE SWIFT Apus affinis Up to 40 seen daily around Pokhara 12th,13th and 25th to the 27th inclusive.
- 41. ALPINE SWIFT Tachymarptis melba 2 seen from the bus over the river on the approach to Mugling on the 27th and at least 3 more, again over the river, at the rear of Riverside Resort, Kurintor (near Mugling) on the same date.

OWL Sp We were unable to identify an owl heard calling at Bamboo in the early hours of the morning on the 17th. The call was a mellow "pupu" repeated at intervals of 12 to 15 seconds (timed independently by Geoff and Martin whilst it was calling). The bird was not seen and the call was unlike any other owl heard on the trip or any other on our Mini disc.

- 42. BROWN HAWK OWL Ninox scutulata A singleheard in the garden of the Hotel Tulsi, Pokhara in the early hours of the 25th, 26th and 27th.
- 43. MOUNTAIN SCOPS OWL Otus spilocephalus Singles heard at Chhomrong on the 16th and below Tadapani on the 19th.
- 44. COLLARED OWLET Galucidium brodiei Singles heard at Bamboo and Kuldi on the 17th and at Ghorapani on the 22nd. 1 was heard at Phulchowki throughout the morning on the 28th.
- 45. ASIAN BARRED OWLET *Glaucidium cuculoides* 1 at Komrong on the 15th; 3 around Pokhara on the 26th; Singles near Mugling on the 27th and at Godaveri on the 28th.
- 46. ROCK PIGEON Columba livia Seen daily except on the trek.
- 47. SNOW PIGEON Columba leuconota A flock of 5 near Diklyo Danda on the way to Chhomrong on the 15th; 30 around this area during the return journey on the 18th and 9 on the way to Chitre from Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th.
- 48. SPECKLED WOOD PIGEON *Columba hodgsonii* A flock of 7 on the lower slopes of Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 49. ASHY WOOD PIGEON Columba pulchricollis A single atGhandruk on the 14th; a flock of 5 at Chhomrong on the 16th, with further Single there on the 17th and 18th.
- 50. ORIENTAL TURTLE DOVE *Streptopelia orientalis* Seen on most days except at Ghorapani on the 21st and 22nd, daily max 8.

- 51. SPOTTED DOVE *Streptopelia chinensis* Singles around Pokhara on the 13th, 26th and 27th; 2 near Birethante on the 14th.
- 52. BLACK-NECKED CRANE Grus nigricollis A superb, elegant bird in the fields at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th. Initially alone, the bird soon joined a feeding party of 7 Black Storks *Ciconia nigra* allowing good views. This vagrant to Nepal is a definite candidate for bird of the trip.
- 53. WHITE-BREASTED WATERHEN *Amaurornis phoenicurus* Up to 4 daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th and 25th to the 27th inclusive.
- 54. COMMON MOORHEN Gallinula chloropus 2 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th, 1 there on the 26th.
- 55. COMMON COOT *Fulica atra* Up to 300 daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 25th to the 27th inc.
- 56. WOODCOCK Scolopax rusticola Singles in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and in the ravine below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th.
- 57. COMMON SNIPE Gallinago gallinago 2 at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 58. COMMON REDSHANK Tringa totanus 3 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 59. COMMON SANDPIPER Actitis hypoleucos 1 Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 25th, 2 there on the 25th.
- 60. BRONZE-WINGED JACANA Metopidius indicus 30 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 61. RED-WATTLED LAPWING Vanellus indicus 5 in the marshy fields at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 62. BLACK KITE Milvus migrans Seen daily except on the trek.15th to the 23rd incl, max 40
- 63. LAMMERGEIER *Gypaetus barbatus* Seen only on the trek, 1 at Birethante on the 13th, 2 Birethante to Gandruk on the 14th; 1 near Chhomrong on the 17th and 1 Tadapani to Deorali Tea Rooms on the 19th.
- 64. EGYPTIAN VULTURE Neophron percnopterus Up to 3 daily around Pokhara on the 13th, 25th and 26th.
- 65. WHITE-RUMPED VULTURE *Gyps bengalensis* Up to 4 daily around Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 26th. A singlebetween Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th.
- 66. HIMALAYAN GRIFFON *Gips himalayensis* Up to 2 daily on the trek 16th and 17th, 19th, 20th and 23rd. An immature bird was at Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 67. EURASIAN GRIFFON Gyps fulvus Up to 2 daily on the trek, 16th, 17th and 19th.
- 68. CINEREOUS VULTURE *Aegypius monachus* Singles at Kuldi on the 17th, near Chitre on the 20th and near Birethante on the 24th.
- 69. RED-HEADED VULTURE *Sarcogyps calvus* 2 around Pokhara on the 13th and 26th. On the trek, 4 between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th and 2 close to Birethante on the 24th.

- 70. CRESTED SERPENT EAGLE *Spilornis cheela* Singles, below Chhomrong on the 16th; near Birethante on the 24th and in the forest at the rear of Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 25th.
- 71. BLACK EAGLE *Ictinaetus malayensis* 2 between Chhomrong and Sinuwa on the 16th.
- 72. MARSH HARRIER Circus aeruginosus A female at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 73. HEN HARRIER Circus cyaneus An adult male over the lower slopes of Poon Hill, Ghorapani on the 21st.
- 74. NORTHERN GOSHAWK Accipiter gentilis Singles below Chhomrong on the 16th and near Kuldi on the 17th.
- 75. SHIKRA Accipiter badius 1 or 2 seen on most days both around Pokhara and on the trek.
- 76. BESRA Accipiter virgatus A pair seen at close range at Sarangkot summit on the 25th.
- 77. COMMON BUZZARD *Buteo buteo* Singles, near Birethante on the 13th and 14th and below Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 78. GOLDEN EAGLE Aquila chrysaetos An immature bird at Kuldi on the 17th.
- 79. STEPPE EAGLE *Aquila nipalensis* A singlenear Mugling on the 11th; 2 at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 13th and further singles at Birethante on the 24th and Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 80. BONELLI'S EAGLE *Hieraatus fasciatus* Singles, at Birethante on the 13th and 24th and over the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 25th.
- 81. BOOTED EAGLE *Hieraaetus pennatus* Singles, at Sarangkot on the 25th and in the ravine, ¼ mile before View Point Lodge on the northern edge of Pokhara on the 26th
- 82. MOUNTAIN HAWK EAGLE *Spizaetus nipalensis* A singlebelow Chhomrong on the 16th; 2 near Sinuwa on the 17th and a pair below Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 83. COMMON KESTREL *Falco tinnunculus* 1 or 2 birds on 7 days of the trip, seen around Pokhara and on the trek.
- 84. PEREGRINE FALCON Falco peregrinus An immature bird seen from the Hotel Tulsi, Pokhara on the 24th and at Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 85. LITTLE GREBE *Tachybaptus ruficollis* Up to 100 seen daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 25th to the 27th, inclusive.
- 86. GREAT CRESTED GREBE *Podiceps cristatus* A single atPhewa Tal, Pokhara on the 25th.
- 87. BLACK-NECKED GREBE *Podiceps nigricollis* 1 on Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 88. GREAT CORMORANT *Phalacrocorax carbo* Up to 30 seen daily around Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 25th to the 27th inclusive. A flock of c 50 flew high NE over Tadapani on the 19th
- 89. LITTLE EGRET *Egretta garzetta* Up to 20 seen daily around Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 24th to the 27th inclusive.

- 90. INTERMEDIATE EGRET *Mesophoyx intermedia* Up to 6 seen daily around Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 24th to the 27th inclusive.
- 91. CATTLE EGRET *Bubulcus ibis* Seen daily around Pokhara. The roost on Phewa Tal, Pokhara held c 500 birds on the 13th.
- 92. GREY HERON Ardea cinerea 4 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 93. INDIAN POND HERON Ardeola grayii. Up to 15 seen daily around Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 24th to the 27th inclusive.
- 94. BLACK STORK Ciconia nigra A flock of 7 feeding in the marshy fields at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 95. ORANGE BELLIED LEAFBIRD Chloropsis hardwickii 1 at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 2 there on the 25th. A single at Shauli Bazaar on the 14th.
- 96. BROWN SHRIKE Lanius cristatus A single at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 97. LONG-TAILED SHRIKE *Lanius schach* A single atMugling on the 11th was considered to be of the s/s *erythronotus*. All others were of the s/s *tricolor* seen around Pokhara and Birethante 12th to 14th inc and 25th to 27th inc, daily max 5. 3 were seen between Chhomrong and Tadapani on the 18th.
- 98. GREY-BACKED SHRIKE *Lanius tephronotus* Seen around Pokhara and near Birethante 12th to 14th inc 24th and 26th, daily max 3.
- 99. RED-BILLED BLUE MAGPIE *Urocissa erythrorhyncha* Up to 12 in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 3 there on the 26th; 2 between Hille and Birethante on the 24th.
- 100. YELLOW-BILLED BLUE MAGPIE *Urocissa flavirostris* 3 near Komrong on the 15th; 1 beyond Chhomrong on the 18th and 2 near Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 101. COMMON GREEN MAGPIE *Cissa chinensis* Singles, at Birethante on the 13th and Hille on the 23rd and 24th; 3 in the ravine ½ mile before View Point Lodge on the northern edge of Pokhara on the 26th.
- 102.GREY TREEPIE *Dendrocitta formosae* Seen in forests around Pokhara and on the lower areas of the trek, 12th to 14th incl and 23rd to 27th incl, daily max 10. Birds were also seen at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 103. SPOTTED NUTCRACKER *Nucifraga caryocatactes* A single near the summit of Poon Hill on the 21st.
- 104. HOUSE CROW *Corvus splendens* Common around Pokhara and in transit to Kathmandu. Absent on the trek.
- 105. LARGE-BILLED CROW Corvus macrorhynchos Seen every day, daily max 80.
- 106. MAROON ORIOLE *Oriolus traillii* Seen on 6 days of the trip, in the forests around Pokhara, on the trek and at Phulchowki, daily max 3.

- 107. LARGE CUCKOOSHRIKE *Coracina macei* Up to 3 daily in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th, 25th and 26th. A single near Shauli Bazaar on the 26th was the only "trek" bird.
- 108. LONG-TAILED MINIVET *Pericrocotus ethologus* Up to 15 seen almost daily in the forests around Pokhara and on the trek.
- 109. SCARLET MINIVET *Pericrocotus flammeus* 4 in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 6 between Birethante and Shauli Bazaar on the 14th were the only records.
- 110. YELLOW-BELLIED FANTAIL *Rhipidura hypoxantha* Seen on 7 days around Pokhara, the lower areas of the trek and at Phulchowki, daily max 3.
- 111. WHITE-THROATED FANTAIL *Rhipidura albicollis* Singles, near Ghandruk on the 14th and at Chhomrong on the 15th.
- 112. BLACK DRONGO *Dicrurus macrocercus* Up to 20 seen daily around Pokhara and in transit to Kathmandu.
- 113. ASHY DRONGO *Dicrurus leucophaeus* Between 1 and 3 seen daily around Pokhara and the lower trek areas 13th to 15th incl and 23rd to 26th incl. 2 at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 114. SPANGLED DRONGO Dicrurus hottentottus Up to 12 daily around Pokhara and Birethante 12th to 14th incl and 24th to 27th incl.
- 115. BROWN DIPPER *Cinclus pallasii* Seen on 7 days of the trek max 6 on the 13th, between Birethante and Shauli Bazaar.
- 116. ASIAN PARADISE FLYCATCHER Terpsiphone paradisi A pair in the gardens of the Riverside Resort Kurintor, near Mugling on the 27th.
- 117. BLUE-CAPPED ROCK THRUSH Monticola cinclorhynchus A male below the summit at Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 118. CHESTNUT-BELLIED ROCK THRUSH Monticola rufiventris Following a male and female near Ghandruk on the 14th, further males were seen between Ghandruk and Chhomrong on the 15th (2), A single at Tadapani on the 18th and 19th and 2 more at Ghorapani on the 21st.
- 119. BLUE ROCK THRUSH Monticola solitarius A female near Birethante on the 24th.
- 120. BLUE WHISTLING THRUSH *Myophonus caeruleus* Seen every day of the trek, max 25 on the 24th.
- 121. ORANGE-HEADED THRUSH Zoothera citrina A single at Fish-tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 25th.
- 122. PLAIN-BACKED THRUSH *Zoothera mollissima* A single atGhandruk on the 15th; 2 at Tadapani on the 19th and 2 or 3 daily around Ghorapani on the 20th to 22nd incl.
- 123. LONG-TAILED THRUSH Zoothera dixoni A single at Ghorpani on the 21st.
- 124. SCALY THRUSH *Zoothera dauma* 2 in the forest behind Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th.

- 125. LONG-BILLED THRUSH Zoothera monticula A single at Ghandruk on the 14th.
- 126. DARK-SIDED THRUSH Zoothera marginata Pokhara
- 127. TICKELL'S THRUSH Turdus unicolor A male at Ghandruk on the 14th.
- 128. WHITE-COLLARED BLACKBIRD *Turdus albocinctus* Up to 10 seen daily on 7 days of the trek +++
- 129. GREY-WINGED BLACKBIRD Turdus boulboul A male and female at Ghandruk on the 15th. +++
- **130.** EURASIAN BLACKBIRD Turdus merula At least 1 by Laligurans Lodge below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th.
- 131. DARK-THROATED THRUSH *Turdus ruficollis* atrogularis Seen on most days of the trip, around Pokhara +++ on the trek daily max 100 on the 23rd, and at Phulchowki
- 132. MISTLE THRUSH *Turdus viscivorus* A single at Tadapani on the 19th; 2 near Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th and 1 at Ghorapani on the 20th.
- 133. DARK-SIDED FLYCATCHER Muscicapa sibirica Phulchowki
- 134. SLATY-BACKED FLYCATCHER Ficedula hodgsonii Pokhara
- 135. RUFOUS-GORGETED FLYCATCHER *Ficedula strophiata* Seen almost daily at Pokhara and on the trek ++++
- 136. RED-THROATED FLYCATCHER Ficedula parva Pokhara and Phulchowki
- 137. SNOWY-BROWED FLYCATCHER *Ficedula hyperythra* A male at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on +++ and a male in the forest between Sinuwa and Kuldi on the 16th and 17th.
- 138. SLATY-BLUE FLYCATCHER *Ficedula tricolor* 6 between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th and single females at Khumnu (between Ghandruk and Chhomrong) on the 15th and below Hille on the 24th.
- 139. VERDITER FLYCATCHER Eumyias thalassina Seen almost daily throughout the trip +++ only 2 singles were seen on the higher areas of the trek, 19th to the 22nd incl.
- 140. GREY-HEADED CANARY FLYCATCHER *Culicicapa ceylonensis* Up to 5 seen daily around Pokhara, the lower trek areas and +++
- 141. SMALL NILTAVA *Niltava macgrigoriae* +++ and at Hille on the 23rd. 6 birds between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th.
- 142. RUFOUS-BELLIED NILTAVA Niltava sundara Seen +++ and the lower trek areas
- 143. PALE BLUE FLYCATCHER Cyornis unicolor Pokhara
- 144. WHITE-BROWED SHORTWING Brachyteryx montana Pokhara
- 145. SIBERIAN RUBYTHROAT *Luscinia calliope* +++ On the trek, a male at Hille on the 23rd and a male at Ramghi (between Hille and Birethante) on the 24th.
- 146. ORANGE-FLANKED BUSH ROBIN Tarsiger cyanurus Seen daily on the trek +++
- 147. GOLDEN BUSH ROBIN *Tarsiger chrysaeus* Brief views of single males at Khumnu and below Chhomrong both on the 15th.

- 148. WHITE-BROWED BUSH ROBIN *Tarsiger indicus* A stunning male in the ravine below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 19th and 2 females on the ridge between Deorali Tea Rooms and Ghorapani on the 22nd.
- 149. RUFOUS-BREASTED BUSH ROBIN *Tarsiger hyperythrus* A male in the ravine below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd.
- 150. ORIENTAL MAGPIE ROBIN *Copsychus saularis* Up to 15 around Pokhara, Birethante +++
- 151. BLUE-CAPPED REDSTART *Pheonicurus coeruleocephalus* Single males at Chhomrong on the 16th and 18th and below Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 152. BLACK REDSTART Phoenicurus ochruros Kurintor +++
- 153. HODGSON'S REDSTART Phoenicurus hodgsoni Phulchowki +++
- 154. BLUE-FRONTED REDSTART *Phoenicurus frontalis* Up to 10 seen daily on the trek +++ Sarangkot on the 25th.
- 155. WHITE-CAPPED WATER REDSTART *Chaimarrornis leucocephalus* Up to 8 seen daily on the trek 13th to the 19th incl and 23rd and 24th.
- 156. PLUMBEOUS WATER REDSTART *Rhyacornis fuliginosus* Similar to previous species with max 25 on the 24th. A pair was at Fish tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 13th and 25th.
- 157. WHITE-TAILED ROBIN *Myiomela luecura* A male at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 25th. (presumably the same bird seen on the Dec '01/March and Dec'02 trips)

- 162. COMMON STONECHAT Saxicola torquata Seen daily around Pokhara 12th, 13th, 25th and 26th, max 20 +++ on the 13th and on the lower slopes of the trek, max 4 on the 18th.
- 163. PIED BUSHCHAT Saxicola caprata +++ Pokhara +++on the 26th.
- 164. GREY BUSHCHAT Saxicola ferrea Up to 15 seen daily on the trek, 14th to 24th incl +++ and the 24th.
- 165. CHESTNUT-TAILED STARLING Sturnus malabaricus +++ Pokhara +++
- 166. COMMON MYNA *Acridotheres tristis* Up to 50 daily around Pokhara and the lower areas of the trek, +++.
- 167. JUNGLE MYNA Acridotheres fuscus Seen daily around Pokhara, max 80+.+++
- 168. CHESTNUT-BELLIED NUTHATCH Sitta castanea ++ Pokhara

- 169. WHITE-TAILED NUTHATCH Sitta himalayensis Up to 8 daily on the trek 15th to the 23rd incl +++
- 170. VELVET-FRONTED NUTHATCH *Sitta frontalis* 1 or 2 in the forest below the Stupa at Pokhara, on the 12th and 26th.
- 171. WALLCREEPER *Tichodroma muraria* Following 1 near Shauli Bazaar on the 14th and 3 between Hille and Birethante on the 24th.
- 172. EURASIAN TREECREEPER *Certhia familiaris* 1 on the ridge between Deorali Tea Rooms and Ghorapani on the 22nd.
- 173. BAR-TAILED TREECREEPER *Certhia himalayana* 1 on the climb from Chitre to Ghorapani on the 20th.
- 174. RUSTY-FLANKED TREECREEPER *Certhia nipalensis* Seen on the trek, mainly around Ghorapani, 19th to the 22nd, incl, max 5 on the 25th.
- 175. BROWN-THROATED TREECREEPER Certhia discolor 1 at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 176. RUFOUS-VENTED TIT *Parus rubidiventris* Up to 10 daily on the trek, 19th to the 23rd incl, mainly around Ghorapani.

COAL TIT / SPOT-WINGED TIT Parus ater/ Parus melanolophus

Around 30 birds seen in the forest below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th. Most of these showed characteristics of "Coal-type" hybrids as we had expected, however a few birds appeared to be more pure Coal tit in appearance but views were inconclusive.

On the 22nd, we encountered 10 more birds on the ridge between Ghorapani and and Deorali Tea Rooms in conifers very near the Deorali Tea Rooms end of the ridge. These were not typical Coal Tit type hybrids but appeared to be pure Coal Tit *P. a. aemodius*. However, individuals seen well showed a hint of cinnamon on the upper breast sides and although this feature was not observed on the other birds we decided not to claim this as an official record on our systematic list.

- 183. WINTER WREN *Troglodytes troglodytes* Up to 4 seen daily on the trek, 19th, 20th and 22nd to the 24th, incl, mainly around Ghorapani.
- 184. PLAIN MARTIN *Riparia paludicola* Daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara 12th, 13th and 24th to the 27th, incl max100+. +++
- 185. BARN SWALLOW *Hirundo rustica* Daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 4th, 5th, 25th and 26th, max 100+.
- 186. RED-RUMPED SWALLOW *Hirundo daurica* Daily at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 4th, 5th, 25th and 26th, max 30.
- 187. NEPAL HOUSE MARTIN *Delichon nipalensis* Around 200 on the walk down to Birethante from Naya Pul on the 13th ++++
- 188. STRIATED BULBUL Pycnonotus striatus 5 birds seen together on the climb up to Sinuwa on the 16th.
- 189. HIMALAYAN BULBUL *Pycnonotus leucogenys* Up to 20 seen on most days. Not seen on the higher areas of the trek 19th to the 23rd, incl.
- 190. RED-VENTED BULBUL *Pycnonotus cafer* Daily around Pokhara on the 4th, 5th, 25th, 26th and 27th, max 30. Seen on the trek only between Birethante and Shauli Bazaar on the 6th.
- 191. ASHY BULBUL Hemixos flavala Pokhara +++
- 192. MOUNTAIN BULBUL HypsipetesMcclellandii 2 near Ghadruk on the 16th. +++
- 193. BLACK BULBUL *Hypsipetes leucocephalus* 7 below Chhomrong on the 18th; 10 near Tadapani on the 19th and 8 at Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 194. STRIATED PRINIA *Prinia criniger* Up to 2 seen or heard on 5 days of the trek, 14th, 15th, 18th, 23rd and 24th. 2 at Sar ++++ on the 26th.
- 195. GREY-BREASTED PRINIA Prinia hodgsonii +++ Kurintor +++
- 196. ZITTING CISTICOLA *Cisticola juncidis* 2 in the marshy fields at the north end of the Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
- 197. ORIENTAL WHITE-EYE *Zosterops palpebrosus* Up to 6 seen on most days of the trip, around Pokhara, on the trek and at Phulchowki.
- 198. CHESTNUT-HEADED TESIA *Tesia castaneocoronata* 1 at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th and 25th.
- 199. GREY-BELLIED TESIA *Tesia cyaniventer* Singles at Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 12th; in the forest Nangathanti on the 23rd and heard at Phulchowki on the 28th.
- 200. COMMON TAILORBIRD *Orthotomus sutorius* Up to 6 daily around Pokhara and the lower trek areas 12th to the 15th, incl and 24th to the 27th incl.
- 201. ABERRANT BUSH WARBLER *Cettia flavolivacea* Singles at Ghandruk on the 14th; on the climb up to Chhomrong on the 15th; Hille on the 24th and at Sarangkot on the 25th.

- 202. GREY-SIDED BUSH WARBLER *Cettia brunnifrons* 2 at Ghandruk on the 14th; 1 below Chhomrong on the 18th; 1 on the ridge between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd and 1 near Hille on the 23rd and 24th.
- 203. LESSER WHITETHROAT Sylvia curruca +++ Pokhara

 Note: Many Phylloscopus/Seicerus warblers were not identified as they moved quickly through the canopy in substantial numbers. The systematic list includes only the birds seen well enough to identify.

- 210. LEMON-RUMPED WARBLER *Phylloscopus chloronotus* Seen almost daily in the forest around Pokhara, on the trek and at Phulchowki, max 30 on the 15th between Ghandruk and Chhomrong.
- 211. HUME'S WARBLER *Phyloscopus humei* 2 in the Boomerang Restaurant gardens, Pokhara on the 12th; 2 at Hille on the 23rd and another there on the 24th.
- 212. GREENISH WARBLER Phylloscopus trochiloides Pokhara +++
- 213. LARGE-BILLED LEAF WARBLER Phylloscopus magnirostris 1 seen at close range in the gardens of Fish Tail Lodge, Pokhara on the 26th.
- 214. WHISTLERS WARBLER *Seicercus whistleri* Up to 4 on most days around Pokhara, the lower slopes of the trek and at Phulchowki. 10 seen between Birethante and Ghandruk on the 14th.

- 236. RED-BILLED LEIOTHRIX *Leiothrix lutea* 2 in the forest below Banthanti Hill (between Tadapani and Deorali Tea Rooms) on the 19th.
- 237. GREEN SHRIKE BABBLER *Pteruthius xanthoclorus* A total of 15 between Bamboo and Sinuwa on the 17th; 1 in the forest below Banthanti Hill on the 19th; 3 between Deorali Tea Rooms and Chitre on the 20th and 1 at Poon Hill on the 21st.
- 238. BLACK-EARED SHRIKE BABBLER *Pteruthius melanotis* A stunning male near Dhiklyo Danda on the way to Chhomrong on the 15th and a female at Hille on the 23rd.
- 239. HOARY-THROATED BARWING *Actinodura nipalensis* Singles, in the forest below Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th and below Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 240. CHESTNUT-TAILED MINLA *Minla strigula* Up to 30 daily on the trek, 15th to the 21st incl and on the 23rd.
- 241. RED-TAILED MINLA Minla ignotincta +++ Pokhara
- 242. RUFOUS-WINGED FULVETTA *Alcippe castaneceps* Up to 10 daily on the trek, 15th to the 23rd incl
- 243. WHITE-BROWED FULVETTA *Alcippe vinipectus* Up to 20 daily on the trek, 15th to the 23rd incl
- 244. NEPAL FULVETTA Alcippe nipalensis +++ Phulchowki
- 245. WHISKERED YUHINA *Yuhina flavicollis* Up to 25 daily on the trek, 15th to the 20th incl. ++++ Phulchowki
- 246. STRIPE-THROATED YUHINA *Yuhina gularis* Up to 20 daily on the trek, 17th to the 23rd incl.
- 247. RUFOUS-VENTED YUHINA *Yuhina occipitalis* Up to 10 daily on the trek, 17th, 20th, 21st and 23rd; 20 were seen between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd.

- 250. GREAT PARROTBILL Conostoma oemodium A single on the climb up to Sinuwa on the 16th and 2 together, with Brown Parrotbills, on the ridge between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd.
- 251. BROWN PARROTBILL Paradoxomis unicolor A party of 12, together 2 Great Parrotbills, performed acrobatically in front of us for several minutes on the ridge between Ghorapani and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 22nd. Amazing!
- 252. FIRE-BREASTED FLOWERPECKER Dicaeum ignipectus A female near Shauli Bazaar on the 14th; a male near Dhiklo Danda (Chhomrong to Tadapani) on the 18th; +++ Pokhara

- 253. MRS GOLD'S SUNBIRD Aethopyga gouldiae 2 males near Chitre on the 20th. Incredibly, they were less than 10 metres from where the male was seen on the March 2002 trip.
- 254. GREEN-TAILED SUNBIRD *Aethopyga nipalensis* Up to 8 seen daily on most days of the trek, 15th and 17th to the 23rd incl.
- 255. BLACK-THROATED SUNBIRD *Aethopyga saturata* Up to 3 seen daily on the trek, 14th to the 16th incl and on the 24th. +++
- 256. CRIMSON SUNBIRD *Aethopyga siparaja* Up to 2 seen daily around Pokhara, including Fish Tail Lodge, Hotel Tulsi gardens and on the trek on the 12th, 14th, and 24th to the 27th incl.
- 257. FIRE-TAILED SUNBIRD *Aethopyga ignicauda* Up to 6 seen daily on most days of the trek, 14th. 15th and 17th to the 23rd incl. +++
- 258. HOUSE SPARROW *Passer domesticus* +++ daily around Pokhara. Not seen on the trek.
- 259. RUSSET SPARROW Passer rutilans Up to 10 almost daily on the trek, 14th to the 16th incl and 18th to the 23rd incl.
- 260. EURASIAN TREE SPARROW *Passer montanus* Up to 6 daily around Pokhara, Kathmandu and the lower trek areas, 12th, 13th, 15th and 23rd to the 28th incl.
- 261. WHITE WAGTAIL *Motacilla alba* At least 100 daily around Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 12th, 13th and 24th to the 27th incl. The rear of Boomerang Restaurant was a favourite spot.
- 262. WHITE-BROWED WAGTAIL *Motacilla madaraspatensis* 3 at Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the +++
- 263. YELLOW WAGTAIL *Motacilla flava* Up to 4 daily +++ at the rear of Boomerang Restaurant Phewa Tal, Pokhara, on the 25th.
- 264. GREY WAGTAIL *Motacilla cinerea madaraspatensis* Up to 7 almost daily around Pokhara, on the trek and at Phulchowki +++
- 265. PADDYFIELD PIPIT *Anthus rufulus* +++ Phewa Tal, Pokhara, mainly lakeside at the rear of Boomerang Restaurant, max 4 on the 5th.
- 266. UPLAND PIPIT Anthus sylvanus 3 in cultivated fields on the climb to Ghandruk on the 14th; 1 below Chhomrong on the 18th ++++
- 267. OLIVE-BACKED PIPIT *Anthus hodgsoni* Seen or heard almost daily throughout the trip, max 25 on the 23rd going to roost near Hille.

- 273. WHITE-RUMPED MUNIA *Lonchura striata* A total of 28 above Shauli Bazaar at the start of the climb to Ghandruk on the 14th; 1 in the Hotel Tulsi gardens on the 24th +++
- 274. DARK-BREASTED ROSEFINCH Carpodacus nipalensis A single near Ghandruk on the 15th; 10 in the forest at Tadapani on the 19th and up to 40 daily in the Ghorapani area, particularly around the lower slopes of Poon Hill, 20th to the 23rd.
- 275. COMMON ROSEFINCH Carpodacus crythrinus A male around 400 metres down the path towards Chitre from the top of Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 276. BEAUTIFUL ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus pulcherrimus* A male at Sinuwa on the 16th; single females at Chhomrong on the 18th and Deorali Tea Rooms on the 20th; a pair at Poon Hill on the 21st and 2 males near Ghorapani on the 22nd.
- 277. PINK-BROWED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus rodochrous* A male at Sinuwa on the 16th and 3 birds at Tadapani on the 19th.
- 278. SPOT-WINGED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus rodopeplus* A female at Chhomrong and a pair at Sinuwa on the 16th; 2 pairs between Kuldi and Sinuwa and a pair at Chhomrong on the 17th; 5 at Tadapani on the 19th and up to 5 daily around Ghorapani 20th, 21st and 23rd.
- 279. WHITE-BROWED ROSEFINCH *Carpodacus thura* A female at Chhomrong on the 16th and 4 birds including a male, at Poon Hill, Ghorapani on the 21st.
- 280. BROWN BULLFINCH *Pyrrhula nipalensis* A flock of 7 by the path below Ghorapani on the 23rd.
- 281. RED-HEADED BULLFINCH *Pyrrhula erythrocephala* Up to 10 daily on the trek, 15th to the 23rd incl. The lower slopes of Poon Hill were a favoured spot.
- 282. CRESTED BUNTING *Melophus lathami* A female in cultivated fields on the climb up to Ghandruk on the 14th; a male near Chiule on the way to Tadapani on the 19th and a female near Hille on the 23rd.
- 283. LITTLE BUNTING Emberiza pusilla 1 skulking in cultivated fields on the climb up to Ghandruk on the 14th. This bird was discovered as we tried to relocate the Upland Pipit and it would have been missed altogether, had we not strayed from the path in search of the pipit.
- 284. YELLOW-BREASTED BUNTING *Emberiza aureola* A total of 30 in the fields at the north end of Phewa Tal, Pokhara on the 13th.
