| 179 | SCALY-BREASTED WREN BABBLER Pnoepyga albiventer | 1 seen near Bhandar on the 20th Nov and at least 14 more heard, over 3 days, between Sete and Surke |
| | PYGMY WREN BABBLER Pnoepyga pusilla | Heard only, 2 in a lake side ravine at Pokhara on the 16th Nov and 1 at Fish Tail Lodge the following day |

| | BLACK-WINGED SNOWFINCH Montifringilla adamsi | 40+ seen at Dugla on the 4th Dec and 400+ seen outside the Eco Lodge, Lobuche on the 5th (see photo) |
| | WHITE WAGTAIL Motacilla alba ? WHITE-BROWED WAGTAIL Motacilla madaraspatensis | Common on the shoreline of Phewa Tal lake, behind the Boomerang Hotel gardens, Pokhara 6 on Phewa Tal lake shoreline, behind Boomerang Hotel gardens, on the 13th Dec |
| | CITRINE WAGTAIL Motacilla citreola | A single, on Phewa Tal lake shoreline, behind Boomerang Hotel gardens, on the 13th Dec |

| | SPOT-WINGED ROSEFINCH Carpodacus rodopeplus | A male seen below the Trakshindo Pass on the 23rd Nov and 2 females below the Khari La Pass on the 25th |
| | HIM WHITE-BROWED ROSEFINCH Carpodacus thura | Seen by Richard at Tengboche on 1st Dec. 2 seen on the way up Mong La and 2 seen near Khunde on 8th Dec |
| 223 | SPOTTED GREAT ROSEFINCH Carpodacus severtzovi | A flock of 6 birds outside the Eco Lodge, Lobuche, on the 4th Dec and 12 there the following morning |
| 224 | RED-FRONTED ROSEFINCH Pyrrhospiza punicea | A female at Duglha on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Dec was the only bird of the trip |

| | WHITE-WINGED GROSBEAK Mycerobas carnipes | Seen on 5 trek days, max 30 on the 7th Dec, between Pangboche and Tengboche |
| | LITTLE BUNTING Emberiza pusilla | A flock of 6 birds, in fields, as we left the village of Bupsa, on the 25th Nov |
| | YELLOW BREASTED BUNTING Emberiza aureola | A flock of 40 birds, at the N end of Phewa Tal lake Pokhara, on the 13th Dec |
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
