Kailash is a scholarly quarterly journal devoted to the Himalayan Studies with special emphasis on the social and cultural aspects of the kingdom of Nepal. Started in 1973 the journal has completed 13 years of its service. During these years, the periodical has made significant contributions in the enrichment of the knowledge of the region by publication of 137 top-class research articles contributed by several Nepalese and foreign scholars. Scattered in 4017 pages of 37 issues of the journal, these articles are collected and arranged in systematic order and repackaged in the following Cumulative Index to help a research student easily locate and identify the articles of his interest by their subject and author. The subject distribution of the 137 articles has been found as follows:
