 - (b) References to articles in periodicals should include author's name, title of the article, name of the periodical, volume, issue number, year and page number cited.
- *Material in Tibetan, Chinese and Russian as well as musical scores must be neatly and clearly prepared on white paper with black ink, and the size of the written area should be 5" X 7 1/2"
- *Authors will receive free thirty offprints of their published contributions. Additional copies must be ordered from the publisher when submitting material.
